**Nurturing Fibres Eco-Fusion** 

9 balls of 125m/50g in Denim 1 ball each of: Aventurine Bordeaux Charcoal Cobblestone

Paris

Hook: 3.75mm & 4.00mm Tapestry Needle

Scissors

#### GAUGE

19 sts x 11 rows = 10x10cm Using a 3.75mm hook working in main pattern

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

beg - beg/inning

ch - chain

chsp/s - chain space/s

dc - double crochet

rep - repeat

sk - skip

RS - right side

tch - turning chain

tr - treble

## IMPORTANT! PATTERN NOTES

- Pattern is written in UK terminology
- Ch3 at the beginning of rows count as 1 tr or work a standing tr for a neater edge. (YouTube has excellent tutorials)



#### INSTRUCTIONS

#### THE BODY

Using a 3.75mm hook and Denim, loosely make 99 ch.

Row 1: (RS) Insert hook in 4th ch from hook and work 1tr in each ch across, turn. (97tr)

Row 2: Ch4 (count as tr & ch1), \*sk next st, 1tr in next st, ch1\*, rep from \* across, 1tr in the 3rd ch of the tch, turn. (48 1chsps)

Row 3: Ch3, work 1tr in each tr and 1chsp across, turn. (97tr)

Row 4: Rep row 2. Fasten off.

Row 5: With Bordeaux rep row 3, fasten off.

Row 6: With Aventurine, ch3, work 1tr in each tr, fasten off and turn.

Row 7: With Paris rep row 6, fasten off.

Row 8: With Denim, rep row 2.

Row 9: Ch4 (count as tr, ch1),

\*1tr in the next tr, ch1\*, rep from

\* to end. 1tr in last tr. turn.

**Row 10:** Rep row 9.

Row 11: Rep row 3.

Row 12: Rep row 2.

**Row 13:** Rep row 3.

Row 14: Rep row 6.

Row 15: Rep row 2, fasten off.

Row 16: With Cobblestone, rep

row 3, fasten off.

Row 17: With Denim, rep rom 6

Row 18 - 22: Rep row 2 & 3.

Row 23 - 24: Rep row 9.

Row 25: Rep row 3, fasten off.

Row 26: With Aventurine, rep

row 6, fasten off.

Row 27: With Cobblestone, reprow 6, Fasten off.

Row 28 – 35: With Denim, reprow 2 & 3.

Row 36: Rep row 6, fasten off. Row 37: With Bordeaux, rep

row 6.

Row 38 - 41; Rep row 2 & 3.

Row 42: Rep row 2, fasten off.

Row 43: With Cobblestone, reprov 3, fasten off.

Row 44: With Charcoal, reprow 6, fasten off.

Row 45: With Aventurine, reprow 6, fasten off.

Row 46 - 53: Rep row 2 & 3.

Row 54; Rep row 2, fasten off.

Row 55: With Paris, rep row 3, fasten off.

Row 56: With Charcoal, reprow 6, fasten off.

Row 57: With Denim, rep row 6, fasten off.

Row 58: With Aventurine, reprow 6, fasten off.

Row 59: With Bordeaux, reprow 6, fasten off.

Row 60: With Denim, rep row 2, fasten off.

Row 61: With Cobblestone, reprow 3, fasten off.

Row 62: With Denim, rep row 2.

**Row 63 - 64:** Rep row 9.

Row 65: Rep row 3.

Row 66 - 67: Rep row 2 & 3.

Row 68: Rep row 2, fasten off.

Row 69: With Bordeaux, rep

row 3, fasten off.

**Row 70 – 73:** With Denim, rep row 2 & 3.

Row 74: Rep row 2, fasten off.

Row 75: With Aventurine, rep

row 3, fasten off.

Row 76: With Cobblestone, reprow 6. fasten off.

Row 77: With Paris, rep row 6. Fasten off.

Row 78 - 83: With Denim, reprow 2 & 3.

Row 84: Rep row 2, fasten off.

Row 85: With Bordeaux, reprow 3 and fasten off.

Row 86: With Charcoal, reprow 6 and fasten off.

Row 87: With Denim, rep row

**Row 88:** Rep row 9.

**Row 89:** Rep row 3.

Row 90: Rep row 2.

**Row 91 - 92:** Rep row 9.

**Row 93 - 96:** Rep row 3 & 2.

Fasten off.

Row 97: With Aventurine, reprow 3, fasten off.

Row 98: With Paris, rep row 6, fasten off.

Row 99: With Cobblestone, rep row 6, fasten off.

Row 100: With Charcoal, reprow 6, fasten off.

Row 101: With Bordeaux, reprove 6. fasten off.

Row 102 - 109: With Denim, rep row 2 & 3.

Row 110: Rep row 2, fasten off.

Row 111: With Aventurine, reproved and fasten off.

Row 112 – 115: With Denim, reprow 2 & 3.

Row 116: Rep row 2 and fasten off.

Row 117: With Bordeaux, reprow 3, fasten off.

Row 118 – 127: Rep row 2 & 3. Row 128: Rep row 2 and fasten off.

Row 129: With Aventurine, reprow 3, fasten off.

Row 130: With Charcoal, reprow 6, fasten off.

Row 131: With Cobblestone, rep row 6, fasten off.

**Row 132 – 135**: With Denim reprow 2 & 3.

Row 136: Rep row 2, fasten off. Row 137: With Bordeaux, rep row 3, fasten off.

**Row 138 - 139:** With Denim, rep row 6.

Row 140 - 145: Rep row 2 & 3.

Row 146: Rep row 2, fasten off.

Row 147: With Charcoal, reprov 3, fasten off.

Row 148: With Aventurine, reprow 6, fasten off.

Row 149: With Denim, rep row 6.

**Row 150:** Rep row 2.

Row 151 - 152: Rep row 9.

Row 153 – 157: Rep 3 & 2, fasten off.

Row 158: With Cobblestone, rep row 6, fasten off.

Row 159 - 160: With Denim, rep row 2 & 3.

**Row 161:** Rep row 6.

Row 162 - 163: Rep row 2 & 3.

Row 164: Rep row 2.

Row 165 - 166: Rep row 9 and fasten off.

Row 167: With Paris, rep row 3 and fasten off.

Row 168: With Aventurine, reprow 6 and fasten off.

Row 169: With Bordeaux, reprow 6 and fasten off.

Row 170 – 174: With Denim, rep row 2 & 3 and fasten off.

# INTERMEDIATE FINISH OFF

Fold the piece in half widthwise, with wrong sides facing, sew the top edge closed, leaving a 31 cm neck opening. Weave in all loose ends around the neck. Don't weave away the bottom ends. This can form part of the tassels.

#### POLO STYLE NECK

With a 4.00mm hook and Denim and with the right side facing, join yarn at the seam.

Round 1: Ch1 (doesn't count as st), work a round of equally spaced dc all around, close with slst. Make sure to end with an EVEN amount of stitches. (Hint: work approx. 2dc's per row edge)

Round 2: Ch4 (count as tr & ch1), \*sk next st, 1tr in next tr, ch1\*, rep from \* across, close with slst in the 3rd ch of the beg ch, turn. (approx. 64 1chsps)

Round 3: Ch4 (count as tr & ch1), \*sk next chsp, 1tr in next tr, ch1\*, rep from \* across, close with slst in the 3rd ch of the beg ch, turn.

Rep round 3 until the neck measures 15cm, or to personal taste.



#### FINISH UP

Weave in all remaining loose ends. Cut pieces of yarn (to personal preference) and add tassels on every second row along the bottom edge. (We used 3 strings per tassel)

#### ABOUT THE YARNS

Eco-Fusion is a uniquely spun yarn with 125 meters to a ball. It is 50% bamboo and 50% cotton & lovingly hand dyed in South Africa.
