# NURTURING FIBRES

## SKILL LEVEL

Advanced Beginner -  
Intermediate

## PATTERN SIZE

One size only

## MATERIALS

Approximately 250g of left  
over Nurturing Fibres  
SuperTwist Sock Yarn in  
different colours  
Hook: 4.00mm  
Tapestry Needle  
Scissors

## GAUGE

This pattern is not gauge  
sensitive.

## ABBREVIATIONS

2trtog – two trebles together  
ch/s – chain/s  
chsp/s – chain space/s  
dc – double crochet  
dtr – double treble  
htr – half treble  
prev - previous  
tr – treble  
sk – skip  
slst – slip stitch  
sp – space  
st/s – stitch/es  
x-st – cross stitch

## IMPORTANT! PATTERN NOTES

- Pattern is written in UK terminology
- Work ch1 at the beginning of dc rounds. This doesn't count as a stitch.
- Work ch1 at the beginning of htr rounds. This doesn't count as a stitch.
- Work ch3 at the beginning of tr rows. This count as a stitch.
- Fasten off and change colour after each round.
- Don't start all the rows in the same place. This will ensure that there is no visible 'seam' but will also make it easier to work away ends as they won't all be in the same place.

## SPECIAL STITCHES

**x-st:** make a tr in the indicated st, then insert the hook in the unworked stitch just *before* the first tr made, make tr as per normal. (the first tr would be positioned second, and the second tr will be positioned first, creating a cross)



## INSTRUCTIONS

With a 4.00mm hook ch200,  
close with a slst in the 1<sup>st</sup> ch,  
but be careful not to twist the  
ch.

**Round 1:** Ch3, 1tr in each tr  
around, close with a slst in the  
3<sup>rd</sup> ch. (200 sts)

**Round 2:** Join yarn in any st  
and ch4 (count as tr, ch1), sk  
next st, \*1tr in next st, ch1, sk  
next st\*, rep from \* all around,  
close with a slst in the 3<sup>rd</sup> ch.  
(100 1chsp)

**Round 3:** Join yarn in any tr.  
Ch1, 1dc in same tr, 1tr in the  
unworked st of round 1, \*1dc in  
next tr, 1tr in next unworked st  
of round 1\*, rep from \* all  
around.

**Round 4:** With the leftover yarn  
from round 1, join yarn in any  
tr, ch1, 1dc in the same st, ch1,  
\*sk next st, 1dc in next st, ch1\*,  
rep from \* all around, close  
with slst in the first st.

**Round 5:** Join yarn in any  
1chsp, ch3, work 1tr in the  
same sp, sk next st, \*2tr in the  
next 1chsp, sk next st\*, rep  
from \* all around, close with a  
slst in the 3<sup>rd</sup> ch.

**Round 6:** Join yarn between  
any two 2tr-groupings, ch3, 1tr  
in the same sp, \*work 2tr  
between the next two 2tr-  
groupings\* rep from \* all  
around, close with a slst in the  
3<sup>rd</sup> ch.

**Round 7:** With the leftover yarn from round 2, join yarn in any tr, ch1, work 1htr in the same st, work 1htr in each st around, close with a slst in the first st.

**Round 8:** Join yarn in any st, ch2, 1tr in the next tr (2trtog created), ch1, \*2trtog over the next 2 tr, ch1\*, rep from \* all around, close with slst in the first 2trtog.

**Round 9:** Join yarn in any 1chsp, ch3, 1tr at the base of the ch3, \*2tr in the next 1chsp\*, rep from \* all around, close with slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch.

**Round 10:** With the leftover yarn from round 3, rep round 7.

**Round 11:** Join yarn in any st, and ch3, work 1tr in the unworked st just before the ch3, \*work 1x-st over the next 2 sts\*, rep from \* all around, close with a slst in the first st.

**Round 12:** With the leftover yarn from round 5, rep round 7.

**Round 13:** Join yarn in any st and rep round 2.

**Round 14:** Join yarn in any tr and rep round 3.

**Round 15:** With the leftover yarn from round 6, join yarn in any tr and rep round 2.

**Round 16:** Join yarn in any tr and rep round 3.

**Round 17:** With the leftover yarn from round 8, rep round 7.

**Round 18:** With the leftover yarn from round 13, join yarn in any st. Ch3, 1tr in the next st, ch2, sk next 2 sts, \*1tr in the next 2 sts, ch2, sk next 2 sts\*, rep from \* all around close with a slst in the 3<sup>rd</sup> ch.

**Round 19:** Join yarn in any tr, ch1, 1dc in the same st, 1dc in the next st, 1tr in the next 2 unworked sts of round 18, \*1dc in the next 2 tr, 1tr in the next 2 unworked sts of round 18\*, rep from \* all around, close with a slst in the first st.

**Round 20:** Join yarn in the 2<sup>nd</sup> dc of any 2dc-grouping, and rep round 11.

**Round 21:** With the leftover yarn from round 9, rep round 7.

**Round 22:** With the leftover yarn from round 11, join yarn *between* any two htr's from the prev round, work 1htr *between* each st all around, close with a slst in the first st.

**Round 23:** Join yarn between any two htr's from the prev round and rep round 22.

**Round 24:** Join yarn in any st, ch3, work 1tr at the base of the ch3, sk next st, \*2tr in next st, sk next st\*, rep from \* all around, close with a slst in the 3<sup>rd</sup> ch.

**Round 25:** Join yarn in any first tr of a 2tr-grouping and rep round 8.

**Round 26:** With the leftover yarn from round 14, join yarn in any 1chsp, ch1, 1dc in same sp, ch1, sk next 2trtog, \*1dc in next 1chsp, ch1, sk next 2trtog\*, rep from \* all around, close with a slst in the first st.

**Round 27:** With the leftover yarn from round 23, join yarn in any 1chsp, ch3, 1tr in the same sp, work 2tr in each 1chsp all around, close with a slst in the 3<sup>rd</sup> ch.

**Round 28:** With the leftover yarn from round 16, join yarn in any st and rep round 7.

**Round 29:** Join yarn in any st and rep round 2.

**Round 30:** Rep round 3.

**Round 31:** With the leftover yarn from round 20, join yarn in any tr and rep round 2.

**Round 32:** With the leftover yarn from round 24, rep round 3.

**Round 33:** Use the leftover yarn from round 25, join in any st and rep round 7.

**Round 34:** Join yarn in any st and rep round 24.

**Round 35:** Join yarn in any st, ch3, work 1tr in each st around, close with a slst in the 3<sup>rd</sup> ch.
