NURTURING FIBRES

PATTERN DIFFICULTY

Advanced Beginners

MEASUREMENTS

Pattern Sizes: 0-3 (3-6, 6-12) months

MATERIALS

Nurturing Fibres SuperTwist Sock Yarn in Monsoon (approx. 20 (25, 30) g)

Or

Nurturing Fibres Eco-Fusion

1x ball 125m/50g in Fawn 3.00mm circular needles 3.25mm circular needles Stitch marker Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

GAUGE

9 sts x 14 rows using 3.00mm needles = 3x3cm

IMPORTANT! PATTERN NOTES

The pattern was knit with the magic loop technique, but double point needles can be used.

ABBREVIATIONS

BOR – beginning of round co – cast on k – knit k2tog – knit two together p – purl psso – pass slipped stitch over s1k1 – slip 1, knit 1 st/s – stitch/es yo – yarn over

INSTRUCTIONS

EDGING

With 3.25mm needles co 80 (88, 96) sts and leave a tail of approx. 1 m.

Change to 3.00mm needles and knit 1 row. Join the ends, place a stitch marker to mark the BOR and knit in the round for 4 (4, 5) rows.

Next row: *yo, k2tog*, rep to end

Next rows: k 8 (9, 9) rows.

Fold along the picot edge and using the cast on tail, sew the cast on row to the U of the last visible row. Take care to pull it in tight as this will give the hat a tight fit.

BODY OF HAT

Next row: P

Next 5 (6, 6) rows: *k3, p1*, rep to

end.

Next row: P

Next 18 (20, 24) rows: *k9 (10, 11),

p1*, rep to end.

CROWN OF HAT

6-12 months only:

Next row: *s1k1 psso, k9, p1*

rep to end.

Next 2 rows: *K10, p1* rep to

end.

3 – 6 (6 – 12) months only: **Next row:** *s1k1, psso, k8, p1*, rep to end.

All sizes:

Next row: *k9, p1* rep to end. Next row: *s1k1, psso, k7, p1*

rep to end.

Next two rows: *k8 p1* rep to end.

Next row: *s1k1, psso, k6 p1* rep to end.

Next row: *k7, p1* rep to end. Next row: *s1k1, psso, k5, p1* rep to end.

Next row: *k6, p1* rep to end. Next row: *s1k1, psso, k4, p1* rep to end.

Next row: *k5, p1* rep to end. Next row: *s1k1, psso, k3, p1* rep to end.

Next row: *k4, p1* rep to end. Next row: *s1k1, psso, k2, p1* rep to end.

Next row: *k3, p1* rep to end. Next row: *s1k1, psso, k1, p1*, rep to end.

Next row *k2, p1*, rep to end. Next row: *s1k1, psso, p1* rep to end.

Next row: *s1k1, psso* rep to end. (8 sts)

Next row: (s1k1, psso, k2) x2

I-CORD

Next 5 rows: $\mbox{\scriptsize K}$

Next row: K2tog, k1, k2tog k1 (4 sts)

SIS

Next 15 rows: K Bind off last 4 sts.

FINISH UP

Weave in all remaining loose ends. Tie the I-cord in a knot.
