

Arm Knitted Throw

THE PATTERN DETAILS

Recommended Yarn: Merino Roving from Nurturing Fibres, split in half and semi felted [if you purchased a kit from us then this was pre-done and all you need do is cast on.]

Needle: You won't need needles, you knit this on your arms 😊

Success of this knitting technique is easily achieved; in fact you will be surprised at how easy it really is. But here are a few pointers:

- 2] If your yarn is not pre-felted it won't last very well. [if you purchased a kit it is pre-felted]
- 3] Make sure to needle felt your ends well together – [also done in our kits]
- 4] The throw is show piece and not designed to be used in high use situations

MAKING THE BLANKET

Simply cast on 18 stitches and follow the technique shown on youtube until all your yarn is used up, leaving enough yarn to cast off. Cast off and sew in the ends.
