## PATTERN DIFFICULTY

Intermediate

## MEASUREMENTS

Pattern Sizes:
Fits teens/adults

## MATERIALS

Nurturing Fibres SuperTwist Sock
1 skein of $320 \mathrm{~m} / 100 \mathrm{~g}$ in Nori
Needles: 4.00 mm 80cm
circular needle
Tapestry Needle
Scissors

## ABBREVIATIONS

T2R: Knit into the FRONT of the 2nd stitch then knit, knit wise into the 1st stitch, then slip both off the needle
T2L: Knit into the back of the 2nd stitch then knit, knit wise into the 1st stitch, then slip both off the needle
SM: Slip marker
RM: remove marker
PM: Place marker
S1: slip one stitch with the yarn at the back of the stitch.
SSK: slip the first stitch as if to knit, slip the second stitch as if to knit, then slide the left-hand needle into the front part of both stitches and knit them together.
S2sk: slip 2 sts as if to k2tog, slip 1 st as if to knit, insert left needle into 3 sts and k3tog through the back loops [central double decrease] Ktbl: Knit through the back loop

## INSTRUCTIONS

## RIBBING

Cast on 112 stitches.
Row 1: lp4, Ktbl, p4 Ktbl, p, 4 Ktbl, Ktbl.] Repeat to end.
Row 2: PM IK4, sl1, K4, sl1, K4.
T2LI Repeat to end.
Row 3: SM [p4, k1, p4, k1, p4, k2] Repeat to end.
Row 4: SM [P4, sl1, p4, sl1, p4.
T2LI Repeat to end.
Repeat rows 3 and 4 for a total of 8 times.

## BODY

Row 19: SM [P4, t2l, p2, t2r, p4, k2] Repeat to end.
Row 20: SM IP5, sl1, p2, sl1, p5. t2ll Repeat to end. $\mathrm{RM}, \mathrm{P} 1, \mathrm{PM}$ this is now the beginning of the row.
Row 21: [P4, t2l, t2r, p4, t2r, t2l] Repeat to end.
Row 22: IP5, sl1, sl1, p5, sl1, p2, sl1] Repeat to end. $\mathrm{RM}, \mathrm{P} 1$, PM this is now the beginning of the row.
Row 23: [P4, ssk, p4, t2r, p2, t2l] Repeat to end.
Row 24: [P4, sl1, p4, sl1, p4, sl1] Repeat to end.
$\mathrm{RM}, \mathrm{P} 1, \mathrm{PM}$ this is now the beginning of the row.
Row 25: [P3, pfb, p3, t2r, p4, t2l] Repeat to end.
Row 26: [P8, sl1, p6, sl1] Repeat to end.
$\mathrm{RM}, \mathrm{P} 1, \mathrm{PM}$ this is now the beginning of the row.
Row 27: [P6, t2r, p6, t2l] Repeat to end.
Row 28: [P6, sl1, p8, sl1] Repeat to end.

RM, P1, PM this is now the beginning of the row.
Row 29: IP4, t2r, p8, t2l] Repeat to end.
Row 30: [P4, sl1, p10, sl1]
Repeat to end.
$\mathrm{RM}, \mathrm{P} 1, \mathrm{PM}$ this is now the beginning of the row.
Row 31: [P2, t2r, p10, t2l] Repeat to end
Row 32: [P2, sl1, p12, sl1] Repeat to end.
RM, P1, PM this is now the beginning of the row.
Row 33: It2r, p12, t2ll Repeat to end.
Row 34: [sl1, p14, sl1] Repeat to end.
RM, K1, PM this is now the beginning of the row.
Row 35: [p14, t2l] Repeat to end.
Row 36: [p14, sl2] Repeat to end.
RM, P1, PM this is now the beginning of the row.
Row 37: [p12, t2r, t2l] Repeat to end.
Row 38: [p12, sl1, p2, sl1]
Repeat to end.
$\mathrm{RM}, \mathrm{P} 1$, PM this is now the beginning of the row.
Row 39: [P10, t2r, p2, t2l]
Repeat to end.
Row 40: [P10, sl1, p4, sl1]
Repeat to end.
RM, P1, PM this is now the beginning of the row.
Row 41: [P8, t2r, p4, t2l] Repeat to end.
Row 42: [P8, sl1, p6, sl1] Repeat to end.
$\mathrm{RM}, \mathrm{P} 1, \mathrm{PM}$ this is now the beginning of the row.
Row 43: [P6, t2r, p6, t2l] Repeat to end.

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Row 44: [P6, sl1, p8, sl1] Repeat to end.
$\mathrm{RM}, \mathrm{P} 1, \mathrm{PM}$ this is now the beginning of the row.
Row 45: [P4, t2r, p8, t2l] Repeat to end.
Row 46: [P4, sl1, p10, sl1]
Repeat to end.
RM, P1, PM this is now the beginning of the row.
Row 45: IP2, t2r, p10, t2l]
Repeat to end.
Row 46: [P2, sl1, p12, sl1]
Repeat to end.
$\mathrm{RM}, \mathrm{P}_{1}, \mathrm{PM}$ this is now the beginning of the row.
Row 47: It2r, p12, t2l] Repeat to end.
Row 48: [sl1, p14, sl1] Repeat to end.
RM, K1, PM this is now the beginning of the row.
Row 49: [p14, ssk] Repeat to end.
Row 50: [p14, sl1] Repeat to end.

The hat should measure approximately 15 cm at this point.

Row 51: [p14, k1] Repeat to end. Row 52: [p14, sl1] Repeat to end.

Should you want a deeper hat then you can lengthen now by repeating rows 51 and 52 . The recommended number of repeats for an adult hat is around seven times.

## CROWN

RM, P7. PM this is now the beginning of the row.
Row 53: [P6, s2sk, p6] Repeat to end.
Row 54: [P6, sl1, p6] Repeat to end.
Row 55: [P5. s2sk, p5] Repeat to end.
Row 56: [P5, sl1, p5] Repeat to end.
Row 57: [P4, s2sk, p4] Repeat to end.
Row 58: [P4, sl1, p4] Repeat to end.
Row 59: IP3, s2sk, p3] Repeat to end.
Row 60: [P3, sl1, p3] Repeat to end.
Row 61: [P2, s2sk, p2] Repeat to end.
Row 62: [P2, sl1, p2] Repeat to end.
Row 63: [p1, s2sk, p1] Repeat to end.

Row 64: [p1, sl1, p1] Repeat to end.
Row 65: [s2sk] Repeat to end. Break end and thread through the live stitches. Bind off.

## FINISH UP

Sew in all loose ends.
