- $2 \times(50 \mathrm{gr}) 4$ ply Eco-bamboo by Nurturing Fibres - Ruby
- 2 x (50gr) 4ply Eco-bamboo by Nurturing Fibres - Bordeaux
- 2 x (50gr) 4ply Eco-bamboo by Nurturing Fibres - Sunglow
- $2 \times(50 \mathrm{gr}) 4$ ply Eco-bamboo by Nurturing Fibres - Sunkissed Coral
- $2 \times(50 \mathrm{gr}) 4$ ply Eco-bamboo by Nurturing Fibres - Sweet Pea
- 2 x (50gr) 4ply Eco-bamboo by Nurturing Fibres - Violet
- 10 x (50gr) 4ply Eco-bamboo by Nurturing Fibres - Charcoal
- 3 mm hook;
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors


## This Pattern uses American Standard Abbreviations

ch - chain
sc - single crochet
hdc - half double crochet
dc - double crochet
$2 d c$ tog in 1 - crochet 2 dc together in 1 stitch
7 dc in 1 - crochet 7 dc in back loop (behind 2 loops - back loop + back knob of the stitch)1 stitch
st - stitch
sl.st. - slip stitch
rep - repeat

## Pattern



Round 1: Work following into magic loop - 2ch, 2dc tog, 2ch, *2dc tog, $2 \mathrm{ch} *$. Repeat *-* 5 times. Finish round -1 ch and 1 hdc following way - with color A yo, hook into top stitch of 1st 2dc tog of this round, yo, pull through, yo with color B and pull through all 3 loops on your hook. See picture \#1


Round 2: (with colour B) 2ch, crochet in hdc from $1^{\text {st }}$ round 2 dc , $1 \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$, crochet in next 2 ch space *1hdc, $3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$. Repeat *-* 5 times. Finish round - crochet in hdc space from $1^{\text {st }}$ round $1 \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, sl.st. into $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ of this round. Cut yarn color B, leaving long enough tail to weave in later. First pull thread end to the front of your motif and then threaded through sl.st. space to the back of your work. See picture \#1


Round 3: Insert your hook in to sl.st space from $2{ }^{\text {nd }}$ round and pick yarn color $A$ from the back of your motif and pull it through creating $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}$. See picture \#2 Now work as follows -2 sc into sl.st. space where you just created $1^{\text {st }}$ ch, 1 sc in next 2 st., 1 sc into 2 dc tog from $1^{\text {st }}$ round, ${ }^{*} 1$ sc into next 2 st, 3 sc into next, 1 sc in to next 2 st, 1 sc into 2 dc tog from $1^{\text {st }}$ round* ${ }^{*}$ rep *-* 5 times. Finish with 1 sc into next 2 st, color change as follows with color A insert hook into sl.st. space from beginning of this round, yo, pull through, with color C yo and pull through 2 loops on your hook.



Round 6: (working with color D) 1ch, *1sc into next 2 st , 1hdc, 1dc, 3dc into next st, 1dc, $1 \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ into next 2 st, 1ch, miss $1^{*}$. Repeat *-* 6 times. Finish this round by sl.st. in to $1^{\text {st }}$ ch of this round. Cut yarn D, leaving long enough tail to weave in later. First pull thread end to the front of your motif and then threaded through sl.st. space to the back of your work. See picture \#4


Round 7: (working with color A) Insert your hook in to $1^{\text {st }}$ sc from $5^{\text {th }}$ round and pick yarn color A from the back of your motif and pull it through creating $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch} .2 \mathrm{ch}$, miss $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{hdc}$, 1 sc into next 3st, 3sc into next st, 1sc into next $3 \mathrm{st}, 1 \mathrm{hdc},{ }^{*}$ miss $1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ into sc from $5^{\text {th }}$ round (work over 1ch from $6^{\text {th }}$ round), miss 1sc, 1hdc, 1sc into next 3st, 3sc into next st, 1sc into next 3st, 1hdc*. Repeat *-* 5 times. Finish this round - miss 1sc, 2dc into sl.sp. space from $5^{\text {th }}$ round where you created your first ch in the begging of this round, sl.st. to $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from beginning. Cut thread by leaving long enough end to weave in later.

Joining hexagons:
I like to plan my color sequence and join hexagons as I go.
Complete your $1^{\text {st }}$ hexagon and with rest of them you will be joining them in 7 round following way.

## Corner Join

Work $7^{\text {th }}$ round to your first "corner", and instead of crocheting 3sc in 1 crochet work in 1 st ( 1 sc , inset hook from the top into middle of 3sc "corner" of your completed hexagon, the working thread should be at the bottom of your work, yo and pull through sc and loop on your hook creating sl.st., 1sc). Then carry on with motif till you get to middle of hexagon side.


Side middle join:
Middle of your side is 3 dc in 1 sc from $5^{\text {th }}$ round - to join work in this st. - ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ halfway join yo, into st, yo, pull 1 loop, you have 3 loops on your hook, yo, pull through 2 loops, insert your hook from the top of $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{dc}$ of "dc 3dc side group" of your complete hexagon, yo, pull through all st. and loops on your hook, 1dc to complete "3dc side group".

## Half of Hexagon "Frida"



Row 1: Work following into magic loop - $2 \mathrm{ch}+1 \mathrm{dc}$ tog, 2 ch, *2dc tog, 2ch*. Repeat*-* 2 times. To finish row crochet $2 d$ ctog, but use color B to go through last 3 loops on your hook of your 2dctog.


Note: you will be running your color A between stitches in this row (like in tapestry crochet). It will let you pick color A at the beginning of row 3.

Row 2: (with color B) 2ch, crochet in 2 ch spaces from $1^{\text {st }}$ row * 1 hdc, 3dc,1hdc) 1ch*. Repeat *_* 3 times. Finish row with 1ch and sl.st. into $2 \mathrm{ch}+1 \mathrm{dc}$ tog from row 1. Cut yarn color B , leaving long enough tail to weave in later.


Row 3: Insert your hook in to sl.st space from $2^{\text {nd }}$ row and pick yarn color A from the back of your motif and pull it through creating $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}$.
Now work following - 1sc into sl.st. space where you just created $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}, * 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in next 2 st ., 3 sc into next, 1 sc in to next $2 \mathrm{st}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ into 2 dc tog from $1^{\text {st }}$ row*. Repeat *_* 3 times.

Note: you will be running your color A between stitches in this row (like in tapestry crochet). It will let you pick color A at the beginning of row 5 .
Row 4: (working with color C) 3ch, 4 dc into sc from $3^{\text {rd }}$ row, miss 3, 1sc, *miss 3, work all 7 dc into back 2 loops of sc from $3^{\text {rd }}$ round, miss $3 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ *. Repeat *-* 2 times. Finish this row with miss $3,4 \mathrm{dc}$ into sc from $3^{\text {rd }}$ row. Cut yarn $C$, leaving long enough tail to weave in later.


Row 5: (working with color A) insert your hook in to last dc from $4{ }^{\text {th }}$ row, pick yarn color A from the back of your motif and pull it through creating $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}$.
Working following - 2 sc into dc from $4^{\text {rd }}$ round, 1sc into each next 3 st, *1sc into middle sc of $3 s c$ group from $3^{\text {rd }}$ round (see diagram), 1sc into each next 3 st, 3 sc in next st, 1sc in to each of next 3 st*. Repeat*_* 2 times. Finish this row with 1sc into each next $3 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in last dc.


Row 7: (working with color A) insert your hook in to last dc from $6^{\text {th }}$ round and pick yarn color A from the back of your motif and pull it through creating $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ into same dc from round 6. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{sc}$ into next 3 st , 1 hdc , miss 1 sc , 3 dc into sc from $5^{\text {th }}$ row (work over 1ch from $6^{\text {th }}$ round), miss 1 sc , 1 hdc , 1 sc into next 3 st , 3 sc into next st*. Repeat *-* 2 times. Finish this row with 1 sc into next 3 st , 1hdc, miss 1sc, 3 dc into sc from $5^{\text {th }}$ row (work over 1ch from $6^{\text {th }}$ round), miss $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ into next 3 st , 2sc into last st. Cut thread by leaving long enough end to weave in later.

How to re-introduce the charcoal thread: Insert your hook in to sl.st space
from $2^{\text {nd }}$ round and pick yarn color A from the back of your motif and pull it through creating $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}$.

Color sequence with in the hexagons:
In every hexagon $1^{\text {st }}, 3^{\text {rd }}, 5^{\text {th }}$ and $7^{\text {th }}$ rounds are done with Charcoal, and rounds $2^{\text {nd }}, 4^{\text {th }}$ and $6^{\text {th }}$ in following colors:
\#1 - Sunglow ( $\left.2^{\text {nd }}\right)$, Violet $\left(4^{\text {th }}\right)$, Sunkissed Coral $\left(6^{\text {th }}\right)$;
\#2 - Sunkissed Coral ( $\left.2^{\text {nd }}\right)$, Ruby $\left(4^{\text {th }}\right)$, Sweet Pea $\left(6^{\text {th }}\right)$;
\#3 - Bordeaux ( $\left.2^{\text {nd }}\right)$, Sweet Pea $\left(4^{\text {th }}\right)$, Violet $\left(6^{\text {th }}\right)$;
\#4 - Sweet Pea ( $\left.2^{\text {nd }}\right)$, Bordeaux $\left(4^{\text {th }}\right)$, Sunglow $\left(6^{\text {th }}\right)$;
\#5 - Violet $\left(2^{\text {nd }}\right)$, Sunkissed Coral( $\left(4^{\text {th }}\right)$, Ruby $\left(6^{\text {th }}\right)$;
$\# 6-\operatorname{Ruby}\left(2^{\text {nd }}\right)$, Sunglow( $\left.4^{\text {th }}\right)$, Bordeaux $\left(6^{\text {th }}\right)$;
Color sequence pattern repeats over 6 hexagons and 4 rows (see diagram)
