## THE PATTERN DETAILS

**Recommended Yarn:** Nurturing Fibres Big Easy

Needle: 8mm

# **Abbreviations:**

T2R: Knit into the FRONT of the 2nd stitch then knit, knit wise into the 1st stitch, then slip both off the needle

T2L: Knit into the back of the 2nd stitch then knit, knit wise into the 1st stitch, then slip both off the needle

SM: Slip marker

RM: remove marker

PM: Place marker

S1: slip one stitch **purl wise** with the yarn at the back of the stitch.

KFB: [This is an increase stitch.] Knit into the front of the stitch and then into the back.

M1: Insert the left needle from front to back into the horizontal strand between the two stitches and then knit through the back loop

STS: stitches

K: Knit

P: Purl

SSK: slip the first stitch as if to knit, slip the second stitch as if to knit, then slide the left-hand needle into the front part of both stitches and knit them together.

#### **THE CROWN**

Cast on 8 sts and join in the round

Row 1: Kfb x8 [16 sts]

Row 2: (k1 [k1, sl1] x3, k1) x2

Row 3: (kfb x2 [k5, kfb]) x2 [22 sts]

Row 4: (k4, [sl1, k1] x3, k1) x2

Row 5: (kfb, k1, kfb, kfb, k6, kfb) x2 [30 sts]

Row 6: (k7, [sl1, k1] x3, k2) x2

Row 7: ([kfb, k1] x3, t2r x3, k1, kfb, k1) x2 [38sts]

Row 8: (k9, [sl1, k1] x3 k4) x2

Row 9: (k8, T2R x3, k5) x2

Row 10: ([k2, kfb] x2, k2, [sl1, k1]x3, k1, kfb, k2, kfb)x2 [46]

Row 11: knit

Row 12: (k10, [sl1, k1] x3, k7) x2

Row 13: (k1, kfb, k8, T2L x3, k7) x2 [48sts]

Row 14: (k12, [sl1, k1] x3, k6) x2

Row 15: (k12, T2L x3, k6) x2

Row 16: (k13, [sl1, k1] x3, k5) x2

Row 17: (k13, T2L x3, k5) x2

Row 18: (k14, [sl1, k1] x3, k4) x2

Row 19: knit

Row 20: (k14, [sl1, k1] x3, k4) x2

Row 21: Knit

Row 22: (k14, [sl1, k1] x3, k4) x2

Row 23: (k13, T2R x3, k5) x2

Row 24: (k13, [sl1, k1] x3, k5) x2

Row 25: (k12, T2R x3, k6) x2

Row 26: (k12, [sl1, k1] x3, k6) x2

Row 27: (k11, T2R x3, k7) x2

Row 28: (k11, [sl1, k1] x3, k7) x2


Row 29: Knit

Row 30: (K11, [sl1, k1] x3, K7) x2

Row 31: Knit 9 sts then place these sts onto a st holder

You will now knit the first earflap.

The earflaps are knitted separately and then a border is added Around the entire hat to give a nice and smooth finish.

## **EARFLAP 1:**

The next 11 sts are worked flat

Row 1: knit 9 sts, k2tog [10sts]

Row 2: p3, [(sl1, p1) x2] sl1, p2tog [9sts]

Row 3: k1, t2l x3, k2tog [8sts]

Row 4: p1, [sl1, p1] x2, Sl1, p2tog [7 sts]

Row 5: Knit

Row 6: P1, p2tog x3 [4 sts]

Break thread, and slip these 4 sts on to the holder

Slip the next 13 live sts onto holder and reserve these for the edging.

# **EARFLAP 2:**

Same as Earflap 1

## **EDGING:**

Once you have finished your 2<sup>nd</sup> earflap, you will have 4 live sts that are still on the left needle, knit these 4 sts and Pick up and knit as follows: 6sts from side of the flap, 13 sts from holder, 6sts from the side of the flap, 4sts from top of flap, 6 sts from side of flap, 13 sts off the holder and pick up 6 sts off the side of the flap. [58sts]

Row 1: purl

Row 2: knit

Row 3: LOOSELY Cast off 15 purl wise, m1, cast off 4 purl wise, m1, cast off 26 purl wise, m1, cast off 4 purl wise, m1, cast off 11 purl wise

Bind off and sew in ends.
