## MATERIALS:

## Supertwist Sock

(100\% Merino, Fingering / 4 ply, 100 grams)
2 skeins Nurturing Fibres Merino, in the colour you desire
Double pointed needles or circular needles 3 or $3,5 \mathrm{~mm}$, depending on your gauge
Stitch markers
Safety pin or large stitch holder
Darning needle.
NOTES: The colour used for the mittens on this pattern is Seaglass.

GAUGE: 24 stitches and 36 rows $=10$ x 10 cm in Stocking stitch. Check your gauge by making a swatch and adjust your needle size if necessary.

## PATTERN:

Cast on: 40-48 stitches. Divide them evenly over the needles, join the round, be careful not to twist stitches.
Work 20 rounds in ribbing knit 2, purl 2.

## Continue:

purl 1 round
knit 2 rounds.
1: * knit 3, purl 1 - repeat from * to end round.
2: repeat round 1
3: * knit 2, purl 1, knit 1 - repeat from

* to end round.

4: repeat round 3
5: * knit 1, purl 1, knit 2 - repeat from

* to end round.

6: repeat round 5
7: *1 averecht, 3 recht - repeat from * to end round.
8: repeat round
9 and 10: Knit all stitches
11 and 12: repeat round 7 and 8
13 and 14: repeat round 5 and 6
15 and 16: repeat round 3 and 4
17 and 18: repeat round 1 and 2
19 and 20: knit all stitches
21: Purl 1 round.
Start thumb gusset. The stitches for the thumb are set between markers for the first 14 rounds. If you are working on circular needles, your first marker is the starting point of the round. You are placing an extra marker when you read
(M). For Double pointed needle users, only one marker is required at (M)
1: Make 2, (M), knit round
2: Knit the entire round
3: Make 1, knit 2, make 1 (M), *purl 1, knit 1. Repeat from * to end round.
4: knit 4, (M), *purl 1, knit 1. Repeat from $*$ to end round.
5: Make 1, knit 4, make 1, (M) *knit 1, purl 1. Repeat from * to end round.
6: knit 6, (M),*knit 1, purl 1. Repeat from $*$ to end round.
7: Make 1, knit 6, make $1(\mathrm{M})$, *purl 1 , knit 1. Repeat from * to end round.
8: knit 8, (M), *purl 1, knit 1. Repeat from $*$ to end round.
9: Make 1, knit 8, make 1, (M) *knit 1, purl 1. Repeat from * to end round.
10: knit 10, (M) *knit 1, purl 1. Repeat from * to end round.
11: Make 1, knit 10, make 1 (M), *purl 1, knit 1. Repeat from * to end round.
12: knit 12, (M), *purl 1, knit 1. Repeat from $*$ to end round.
13: Make 1, knit 12, make $1(\mathrm{M})$, knit round
14: knit 14 (M) knit round.
15: Place 14 stitches on a safety pin or stitch holder. Make 4 extra stitches, purl round.
16: Purl the entire round.
17: SSK, k2 tog, knit round
18: SSK, k2 tog, knit round.
You are now back to $40-48$ stitches.
19: *knit 7, purl 1. Repeat from * to end round.
20: *purl 1, knit 5, purl 1, knit 1.
Repeat from * to end round.
21: *knit 1, purl 1, knit 3, purl 1, knit 2. Repeat from * to end round.
22: *knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 3. Repeat from * to end round.
23: *knit 3, purl 1, knit 4. Repeat from * to end round.

24 and 25: knit all stitches
26: purl all stitches
27 and 28: knit all stitches
29 and 30: *knit 2, purl 2. Repeat from * to end round.

31 and 32: *purl 2, knit 2. Repeat from * to end round.

33 and 34: *knit 2, purl 2. Repeat from * to end round.

35 and 36: *purl 2, knit 2. Repeat from * to end round.

37 and 38: *knit 2, purl 2. Repeat from * to end round.

39 and 40: knit all stitches
41 and 42: purl all stitches
43 and 44: knit all stitches
45: *knit 3, purl 1. Repeat from * to end round.

46: *purl 1, knit 1. Repeat from * to end round.

47: *knit 1, purl 1, knit 2. Repeat from * to end round.

48: *purl 1, knit 1. Repeat from * to end round.
Repeat round 45-48 until the little finger is completely covered.
Decreases for the top of the hand:
Work as much as possible in pattern rounds 45-48, but decrease as following:
Round 1: knit 1, SSK, work in pattern until 3 sts before halfway point, k2tog, k1, k1, SSK, work in pattern until 3 sts before end, k2tog, k1.
Round 2: work in pattern, without decreases.
Repeat round 1 and 2 until there are 20 sts left in total.
Repeat round 1 only until there are 4 6 sts left in total.
Cut yarn at approximately 15 cm (6 inches) from work. Thread needle and pull yarn through remaining stitches. Close top, fixate and weave in on the inside of the mitten.
Weave in other ends as well.
Thumb: Place stitches on stitch holder or safety pin back on the needles. Pick up $4-6$ sts around thumb gap. Knit in the round until a length is reached that is $1 / 2 \mathrm{~cm}$ below the top of the tumb.

## Decrease:

- Knit together 2 sts during the entire round.
- Knit 1 round.

Cut yarn at approximately 15 cm (6 inches) from work. Thread needle and pull yarn through remaining stitches. Close top, fixate and weave in on the inside of the mitten.
Weave in other ends as well.
Work second mitten.
