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PATTERN DIFFICULTY

Intermediate

MEASUREMENTS

Pattern Size:
Adult size

MATERIALS

Nurturing Fibres SuperTwist DK
2 skeins of 105m/50g in Monette (main colour)
1 skein of 105m/50g in Shipwrecked
(contrasting colour)
Needles: 4.00mm (DPN or Circular)
Stitch marker
Tapestry Needle
Scissors



INSTRUCTIONS

With contrasting colour, cast on 120 sts. You can use any cast on, as long as it gives a neat edge and remains stretchy. Join in the round, making sure to not twist your stitches.

Change to main colour and follow the chart, starting from the bottom row. The rib is a twisted rib and is knitted for 12 rows and is included in on the chart.

FINISH UP

Snip the thread and with darning needle thread through the live stitches. Bind off and sew in ends.

ABOUT THE YARNS

SuperTwist DK is a squishy yarn that is 100% merino wool that is from non-mulesed. It has 103m to a skein and is lovingly hand-dyed in South Africa.
