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PATTERN DIFFICULTY

Easy

MEASUREMENTS

Pattern Sizes:

One size fits all

Width: approx. 40cm

Length: approx. 160cm

MATERIALS

Nurturing Fibres Eco-Fusion

5 balls of 125m/50g in Bessy

Hook: 4.00mm

Tapestry Needle

Scissors

GAUGE

3 patt repeats x 6 rows =

10x10cm using a 4.00mm hook

ABBREVIATIONS

ch – chain

chsp – chain space

sk – skip

tr – treble

IMPORTANT! PATTERN NOTES

- Pattern is written in UK terminology
- Work ch3 at the beginning of tr rounds. This counts as a stitch.



INSTRUCTIONS

Using a 4.00mm hook, loosely make 64 ch.

Row 1: (4tr, ch3, 1tr) in 4th ch from hook, *sk next 4ch, (4tr, ch3, 1tr) in next ch*, rep from * across to last 3ch, sk next 2ch, 1tr in last ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch3 (count as tr), (4tr, ch3, 1tr) in each 3chsp across to last 3chsp, sk next 4tr, 1tr in 3rd ch, turn.

Rep row 2 until all 5 balls of yarn are finished.

FINISH UP

Weave in all loose ends. Block according to measurements given. Join the two short ends together.

ABOUT THE YARNS

Eco-Fusion is a uniquely spun yarn with 125 meters to a ball. It is 50% bamboo and 50% cotton and is lovingly hand-dyed in South Africa.

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
