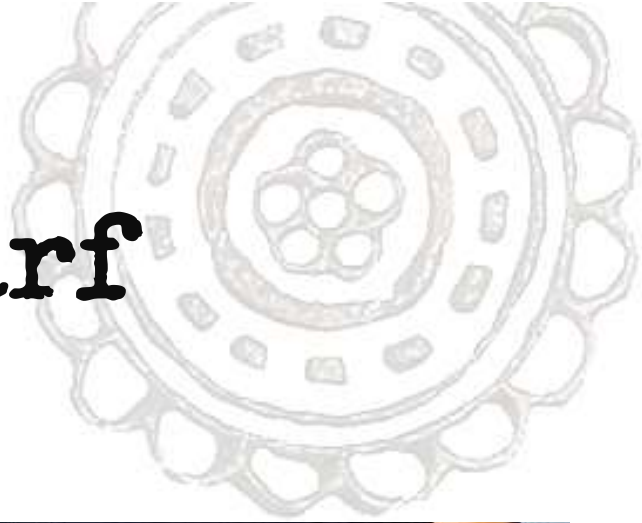


Moon Tide Scarf

PATTEN DIFFICULTY

Medium

MEASUREMENTS

Cm x cm

MATERIALS

Eco-Fusion(50grams)

1x Mist [colour A]
1 x Aqua [colour B]
1x Anvil [colour C]
3.50 Hook
Tapestry needle
Scissors

IMPORTANT! PATTERN NOTES

Tension is not important for this pattern, but remember that you do want the scarf to have lovely, soft drape.

This pattern is written using US Crochet Terminology

After each row, turn your work

ABBREVIATIONS

ch – chain
sc – single crochet
dc – double crochet
st – stitch
sl.st. – slip stitch
rep – repeat

Note – 3ch at the beginning of each row counts as dc.

INSTRUCTIONS

Using Colour A

Chain 6.

Row 1: (1dc, 1ch, 2dc) into 4th ch from the hook, 1ch, miss 1ch, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into next ch (last one).

Row 2: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in to 2ch space, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into next 1ch space.

Row 3: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) in to 1ch space, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into next 1ch space.

Row 4: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 1ch, 9 hdc into next 1ch space, 1ch, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 5: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 1ch, *1dc and 1ch* in each of 9hdc from previous row, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 6: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, *1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch* - rep from *-* 7 times (you will have 7 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 7: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, *1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch* - rep from *-* 6 times (you will have 6 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 8: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, *1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch* - rep from *-* 5 times (you will have 5 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 9: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, *1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch* - rep from *-* 4 times (you will have 4 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 10: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, *1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch* - rep from *-* 3 times (you will have 3 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 11: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, *1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch* - rep from *-* 2 times (you will have 2 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 12: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, 1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 13: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Repeat row 1** – 13 x 8* times. But adjust your 1st row and work your (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into 1ch spaces rather than chains.



JOINING

Using Color B

****PATTERN NOTE**** - ONLY join 2nd color to the edge of every 2nd row of already existing scarf in color A—starting with 6th row. (see how to do it below highlighted in red) Join on rows - 7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17, 19 etc.

Join color B with sl.st. to the last dc from 6th row of Color A scarf and chain 6 – ***see diagram***.

Row 1: (1d, 1ch, 2dc) into 4th ch from the hook, 2ch, miss 1ch, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into 2nd last ch. Join scarf by sl.st. to 3rd chain of 7th row of scarf color A.

Row 2: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in to 2ch space, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into next 1ch space.

Row 3: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) in to 1ch space, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into next 1ch space. Join scarf by

sl.st. to 3rd chain or top of your last dc from 9th row of scarf color A.

Row 4: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 2ch, 9 dc into next 1ch space, 2ch, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 5: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 1ch, 1dc and 1ch in each of 9dc from previous row, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space. Join scarf by sl.st. to 3rd chain or top of your last dc from 11th row of scarf color A.

Row 6: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, *1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch* - rep from *-* 7 times (you will have 7 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 7: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, *1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch* - rep from *-* 6 times (you will have 6 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space. Join scarf by sl.st. to 3rd chain or top of your last dc from 13th row of scarf color A.

Row 8: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, *1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch* - rep from *-* 5 times (you will have 5 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 9: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, *1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch* - rep from

- 4 times (you will have 4 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) in to last 1ch space. Join scarf by sl.st. to 3rd chain or top of your last dc from 15th row of scarf color A.

Row 10: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, *1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch* - rep from *-* 3 times (you will have 3 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 11: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc)

in same 1ch space, 3ch, *1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch* - rep from *-* 2 times (you will have 2 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space. Join scarf by sl.st. to 3rd chain or top of your last dc from 17th row of scarf color A.

Row 12: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, 1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 13: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space. Join scarf by sl.st. to 3rd chain or top of your last dc from 19th row of scarf color A.

Repeat row 1-13 x 8 times, but on your 8th repeat of 13 rows work as following – 1-7 row as above, joining to the edge of scarf color A and rest of 7 – 14 rows work **without** joining.

Finish to create pointy leaf - sl.st. along first 2dc and 1ch space,

3ch, 2dc in same 1ch space, 3dc into last 1ch space - * crochet together like a puff stitch.

Using Color C

Crochet and join colour C to colour B in the same manner that you joined Colour B to colour AB.

Finish scarf by sewing in threads and block.

ABOUT THE YARN

Eco-Fusion is a uniquely spun yarn with 125 meters to a ball.

It is 50% bamboo and 50% cotton & lovingly Hand dyed in South Africa.

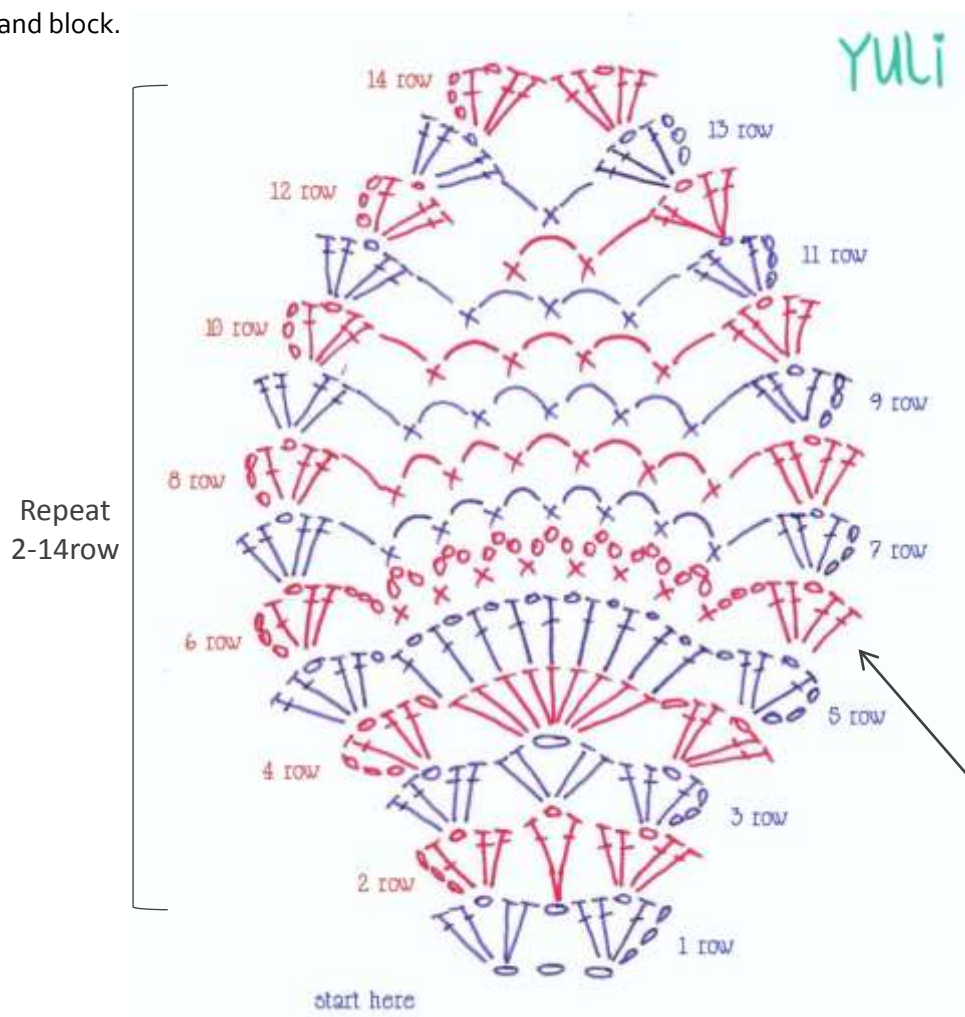
