NURTURING FIBRES

PATTERN DIFFICULTY

Easy

MEASUREMENTS

Pattern Sizes:

No set pattern size.

Completed measurements:

According to your own measurements of your pot plant holder.

MATERIALS

Nurturing Fibres Eco-Fusion

(50g/125m)

1x Vanilla

As many different coloured bonbons (10g/25m) for the hearts

Hook: 3.50mm

Tapestry Needle

Scissors

Peace In The Home plant and pot plant holder

ABBREVIATIONS

ch – chain

chsp – chain space

cont - continue

dc – double crochet

slst – slip stitch

sk – skip

tr - treble

GAUGE

This project is not gauge sensitive.

IMPORTANT!

PATTERN NOTES

- Pattern is written in UK terminology
- Work ch3 at the beginning of tr rounds. This counts as a stitch.
- Work 1ch at beginning of dc rounds. This doesn't count as a stitch.

- The pattern is completely adjustable. I used the following measurements: The circumference of the plant holder at the top rim: 47cm, my base ch was 90 chains.

INSTRUCTIONS



TOP SECTION

With Vanilla and a 3.50mm hook, ch a length of ch that will fit snug around the top edge of your pot plant holder, making sure that the chain is divisible by 6. Close with a slst, making sure not to twist the ch.

Row 1: Ch1, 1dc in each ch across, close with a slst in first dc. Fasten off.

Row 2: With any contrasting colour, join yarn in any st and work 1dc in each dc around. Fasten off.

Row 3: With Vanilla, join yarn in any st, work 1dc in each dc, close with a slst.

Row 4: Ch1, 1dc in same st, *sk next 2 sts, (3tr, ch2, 3tr) in next

st, sk next 2 sts, 1dc in next st*, rep from * all around, omit the dc in the final repeat, close with a slst in the first dc. Fasten off.

Weave in all loose ends.

HEARTS

With Sunglow, make 4ch. Insert hook in 4th ch from hook and make (3dtr, 3tr, 3dtr, 3tr, 3dtr, ch3), close with slst in same ch. Ch5, and join to any 2chsp of the top section.

Continue making hearts until all the 2chsp's of the top section have one.

Weave in all remaining loose ends.



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ABOUT THE YARNS

Eco-Fusion is a uniquely spun yarn with 125 meters to a ball. It is 50% bamboo and 50% cotton & lovingly hand dyed in South Africa.
