### MATERIALS

Eco-Fusion 125m/50g balls: 3x Orchid [colour A] 3x Pickled Ginger [colour B] 2x Sweet Pea [colour C] 3.5mm Hook Tapestry needle Scissors

# IMPORTANT! PATTERN NOTES

Tension is not important for this pattern but remember that you do want a finished item with a lovely soft drape. This pattern is written using US Crochet Terminology. After each row, turn your work. 3ch at the beg of each row counts as dc.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch – chain sc – single crochet dc – double crochet st – stitch sl.st. – slip stitch rep – repeat



### INSTRUCTIONS

Using Colour A Chain 6.

Rw 1: (1d, 1ch, 2dc) into 4th ch from the hook, 1ch, miss 1ch, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into next ch (last one).

Row 2: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in to 1ch space, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into next 1ch space.

Row 3: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) in to 1ch space, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into next 1ch space.

Row 4: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 1ch, 9 hdc into next 1ch space, 1ch, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 5: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 1ch, \*1dc and 1ch\* in each of 9hdc from previous row, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 6: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, \*1sc in 1ch space, 3 ch\* - rep from \*-\* 8 times (you will have 7 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 7: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, \*1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch\* - rep from \*-\* 7 times (you will have 6 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 8: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, \*1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch\* - rep from \*-\* 6 times (you will have 5 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 9: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, \*1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch\* - rep from \*-\* 5 times (you will have 4 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 10: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, \*1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch\* - rep from \*-\* 4 times (you will have 3 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 11: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, \*1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch\* - rep from \*-\* 3 times (you will have 2 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 12: 1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, \*1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch\* - rep from \*-\* 2 times (you will have 1 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 13: 1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, 1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 14: 1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Repeat row 2 - 14 x 10 times.

#### **JOINING**

Colour B/1

\*\*PATTERN NOTE\*\* - ONLY join 2nd color to the edge of every 2<sup>nd</sup> row of already existing scarf in color A-starting with 6<sup>th</sup> row. (see how to do it below highlighted in red) Join on rows -7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17, 19etc.

Join colour B with sl.st. to the last dc from 6<sup>th</sup> row of Color A scarf and chain 6 – \*see diagram\*.

Row 1: (1dc, 1ch, 2dc) into 4<sup>th</sup> ch from the hook, 2ch, miss 1ch, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into 2<sup>nd</sup> last ch. Join scarf by sl.st. to 3<sup>rd</sup> chain of 7<sup>th</sup> row of scarf colour A

Row 2: 1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in to 2ch space, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into next 1ch space.

Row 3: 1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) in to 1ch space, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into next 1ch space. Join scarf by sl.st. to 3<sup>rd</sup>chain or top of your last dc from 9<sup>th</sup> row of scarf colour A.

Row 4: 1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 2ch, 9 dc into next 1ch space, 2ch, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 5: 1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 1ch, 1dc and 1ch in each of 9dc from previous row, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space. Join scarf by sl.st. to 3<sup>rd</sup>chain or top of your last dc from 11<sup>th</sup> row of scarf colour A.

Row 6: 1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, \*1sc in 1ch space, 3 ch\* - rep from \*-\* 8 times (you will have 7 - 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 7: 1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, \*1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch\* - rep from \*-\* 7 times (you will have 6 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space. Join scarf by sl.st. to 3<sup>rd</sup>chain or top of your last dc from 13<sup>th</sup> row of scarf colour A.

Row 8: 1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, \*1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch\* - rep from \*-\* 6 times (you will have 5 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 9: 1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, \*1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch\* - rep from \*-\* 5 times (you will have 4 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space. Join scarf by sl.st. to 3<sup>rd</sup>chain or top of your last dc from 15<sup>th</sup> row of scarf colour A.

Row 10: 1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, \*1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch\* - rep from \*-\* 4 times (you will have 3 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 11: 1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, \*1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch\* - rep from \*-\* 3 times (you will have 2 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space. Join scarf by sl.st. to 3<sup>rd</sup>chain or top of your last dc from 17<sup>th</sup> row of scarf colour A.

Row 12: 1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, \*1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch\* - rep from \*-\* 2 times (you will have 1 – 3ch arches), (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Row 13: 1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, 3ch, 1sc into 3ch space (arch), 3ch, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space. Join scarf by sl.st. to 3<sup>rd</sup>chain or top of your last dc from 19<sup>th</sup> row of scarf colour A.

Row 14: 1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, (3ch, 1dc, 1ch, 2dc) in same 1ch space, (2dc, 1ch, 2dc) into last 1ch space.

Repeat row 2-14 x 9 times.

After 9<sup>th</sup> repeat finish as follows:

1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, to create pointy end crochet like puff stitch \*3ch, 2dc in same 1ch space, 3dc into next 1ch space\* - pull yarn through all loops on your hook and join to color A scarf with sl.st.



Using Colour C/1: Crochet and join same way as with colour B, but now instead of joining to colour A you will be joining B.

Repeat row 2-14 x 8 times. After 8th repeat finish as follows:

1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, to create pointy end crochet like puff stitch \*3ch, 2dc in same 1ch space, 3dc into next 1ch space\* - pull yarn through all loops on your hook and join to color B/1 scarf with sl.st.

Using Colour A/2: Crochet and join same way as with colour C, but now instead of joining to colour B you will be joining to colour C.

Repeat row 2-14 x 7 times. After 7th repeat finish as following:

1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, to create pointy end crochet like puff stitch \*3ch, 2dc in same 1ch space, 3dc into next 1ch space\* - pull yarn through all loops on your hook and join to colour C scarf with sl.st.

Using Colour B/2: Crochet and join same way as with colour B, but now instead of joining to colour C you will be joining A.

Repeat row 2-14 x 6 times. After 6<sup>th</sup> repeat finish as following:

1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, to create pointy end crochet like puff stitch \*3ch, 2dc in same 1ch space, 3dc into next 1ch space\* - pull yarn through all loops on your hook and join to color A scarf with sl.st.

Using Colour C/2: Crochet and join same way as with colour B, but now instead of joining to colour A/2 you will be joining B.

Repeat row 2-14 x 5 times. After 5th repeat finish as following:

1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, to create pointy end crochet like puff stitch \*3ch, 2dc in same 1ch space, 3dc into next 1ch space\* - pull yarn through all loops on your hook and join to colour B scarf with sl.st.

Using Colour A/3: Crochet and join same way as with colour C. but now instead of

joining to colour B you will be joining to colour C.

Repeat row 2-14 x 4 times. After 4th repeat finish as following:

1ch, sl.st. into 2nd dc and 1ch space, to create pointy end crochet like puff stitch \*3ch, 2dc in same 1ch space, 3dc into next 1ch space\* - pull yarn through all loops on your hook and join to colour C scarf with sl.st.

Using Colour B/3: Crochet and join same way as with colour B, but now instead of joining to colour C you will be joining A.

Repeat row 2-14 x 3 times. After 3<sup>th</sup> repeat finish as following:

1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, to create pointy end crochet like puff stitch \*3ch, 2dc in same 1ch space, 3dc into next 1ch space\* - pull yarn through all loops on your hook and join to colour A scarf with sl.st.

Using Colour C/3: Crochet and join same way as with colour B, but now instead of joining to colour A you will be joining B.

Repeat row 1-14 x 2 times. After 2nd repeat finish as following:

1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, to create pointy end crochet like puff stitch \*3ch, 2dc in same 1ch space, 3dc into next 1ch space\* - pull yarn through all loops on your hook and join to colour B scarf with sl.st.

Using Colour A/4: Crochet and join same way as with colour C, but now instead of joining to colour B you will be joining to colour C.

Repeat row 1-14 x 1 times.

After 1<sup>th</sup> repeat finish as following:

1ch, sl.st. into 2<sup>nd</sup> dc and 1ch space, to create pointy end crochet like puff stitch \*3ch, 2dc in same 1ch space, 3dc into next 1ch space\* - pull yarn trough all loops on your hook and join to colour C scarf with sl.st.

Finish shawl by fastening threads and blocking to give it a shape.

Eco-Fusion is a uniquely spun yarn designed by Nurturing Fibres. It has 125 meters to a ball. It is 50% bamboo and 50% cotton & Hand dyed in South Africa.
