4mm hook

Stitch markers

Tapestry needle for weaving
in ends

GAUGE

17 tr x 11 rows = 10x10cm using
a 4.00mm hook when working
the collar section (blocked
measurements)

ABBREVIATIONS

2dctog – 2 double crochet
together

beg – beg/inning

ch – chain

chsp – chain space

dc – double crochet

dc spike – Insert hook into st
indicated 1 round below last

round worked, yarn over and
work dc as per normal.

sk – skip/ped

slst – slip stitch

tr – treble



IMPORTANT! PATTERN NOTES

- Pattern is written in UK terminology
- Work ch1 at the beginning of dc rounds. This doesn't count as a stitch.
- Work ch3 at the beginning of tr rounds. This counts as a stitch.
- Chains in the stitch pattern count as a stitch.
- When working in spaces around the collar, work stitches in the space, NOT in the chains, unless otherwise indicated.

INSTRUCTIONS

Using a 4.00mm hook, and colour Anvil loosely make 120 ch. Close with a slst but be careful not to twist the ch.

Round 1: Ch3, 1tr in each ch around, close with slst in 3rd ch. (120 sts)

Round 2: Ch4 (count as tr, ch1), sk next tr, *1tr in next tr, ch1, sk next tr*, rep from * all around, close with slst in 3rd ch. (120 sts)

Round 3: *1tr in next 9 sts, 2tr in next st*, rep from * all around, close with slst in 3rd ch. (132 sts)

Round 4: Rep round 2. (132 sts)

Round 5: *1tr in next 10 sts, 2tr in next st*, rep from * all around, close with slst in 3rd ch. (144 sts) **Fasten off.**

Round 6: With Violet join yarn in any st and rep round 2. (144 sts) **Fasten off.**

Round 7: With Ruby Pink join yarn in any st. *1tr in next 11 sts, 2tr in next st*, rep from * all around, close with slst in 3rd ch. (156 sts) **Fasten off.**

Round 8: With Lime join yarn in any st and rep round 2. (156 sts) **Fasten off.**

Round 9: With Aventurine join yarn in any st. *1tr in next 12 sts, 2tr in next st*, rep from * all around, close with slst in 3rd ch. (168 sts) **Fasten off.**

Round 10: With Forest, join yarn in any st. Ch4 (count as tr, ch1), sk next st, (1tr, ch1, sk next st) 5 times, 1tr, ch2, sk next st, *(1tr, ch1, sk next st) 6 times, 1tr, ch2, sk next st*, rep from * all

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around, close with slst in 3rd tr. (180 sts) **Fasten off.**

Round 11: With Bordeaux join yarn in any st. Ch3, *1tr in next 14 sts, 2tr in next st*, rep from * all around, close with slst in 3rd ch. (192 sts) **Fasten off.**

Round 12: With Paris, join yarn in any st. Ch4 (count as tr, ch1), sk next st, (1tr, ch1, sk next st) 6 times, 1tr, ch2, sk next st, *(1tr, ch1, sk next st) 7 times, 1tr, ch2, sk next st*, rep from * all around, close with slst in 3rd tr. (204 sts) **Fasten off.**

Round 13: With Lavender join yarn in any st. Ch3, *1tr in next 16 sts, 2tr in next st*, rep from * all around, close with slst in 3rd ch. (216 sts) **Fasten off.**

Round 14: With Sunglow, join yarn in any st. Ch4 (count as tr, ch1), sk next st, (1tr, ch1, sk next st) 7 times, 1tr, ch2, sk next st, *(1tr, ch1, sk next st) 8 times, 1tr, ch2, sk next st*, rep from * all around, close with slst in 3rd tr. (228 sts) **Fasten off.**

Round 15: With Sunkissed Coral join yarn in any st. Ch3, *1tr in next 18 sts, 2tr in next st*, rep from * all around, close with slst in 3rd ch. **First Size Only: complete round as indicated, but at regular intervals omit 2 decreases, ending with a stitch count of 238.** (240 sts second and third size only) **Fasten off.**

Second and Third Size Only:

Round 16: With Lime, join yarn in any st. Ch4 (count as tr, ch1), sk next st, (1tr, ch1, sk next st) 8 times, 1tr, ch2, sk next st, *(1tr, ch1, sk next st) 9 times, 1tr, ch2, sk next st*, rep from * all

around, close with slst in 3rd tr. (252 sts) **Fasten off.**

Round 17: With Aventurine join yarn in any st. Ch3, *1tr in next 20 sts, 2tr in next st*, rep from * all around, close with slst in 3rd ch.

Second Size Only: complete round as indicated, but at regular intervals add 2 more stitches, ending with a stitch count of 266. (264 sts, third size only) **Fasten off.**

Third Size Only

Round 18: With Forest, join yarn in any st. Ch4 (count as tr, ch1), sk next st, (1tr, ch1, sk next st) 9 times, 1tr, ch2, sk next st, *(1tr, ch1, sk next st) 10 times, 1tr, ch2, sk next st*, rep from * all around, close with slst in 3rd tr.

Third Size Only: complete round as indicated, but at regular intervals add 4 stitches, ending with a stitch count of 280. (280 sts) **Fasten off.**

All sizes:

Next Round: With Ruby Pink, join yarn in any st. Ch1 (doesn't count as st) 1dc in same st, ch4, sk next 2 sts, 1dc in next st, ch3, sk next 3 sts, *1dc in next st, ch4, sk next 2 sts, 1dc in next st, ch3, sk next 3 sts*, rep from * all around, close with slst in 1st dc.

Next round: Slst in 4chsp, ch3 (count as tr), work 8 tr in 4chsp, 1dc spike in the 2nd sk st of 1 round below, *gtr in next 4chsp, 1dc spike in the 2nd sk st of 1 round below*, rep from * all around, close with slst in 3rd ch. 34 (38, 40) scallops. **Fasten off.**

Next round: With Violet, join yarn in the 7th tr of any scallop. Ch1 (doesn't count as st), 1dc in same st, ch4, 1dc in the 3rd tr of next scallop, ch3, *1dc in the 7th tr of current scallop, ch4, 1dc in the 3rd tr of next scallop, ch3, sk next 3 tr*, rep from * all around, close with slst in first dc.

Next round: Slst in 4chsp, ch3 (count as tr), work 8 tr in 4chsp, 1dc spike in the 2nd sk st of 1 round below, *gtr in next 4chsp, 1dc spike in the 2nd sk st of 1 round below*, rep from * all around, close with slst in 3rd ch. 34 (38, 40) scallops. **Fasten off.**

Rep the previous 2 rounds, working 2 rounds per colour in the following sequence:

Lime
Aventurine
Forest
Bordeaux
Paris
Lavender
Sunglow
Sunkissed Coral

BORDER

With Ruby Pink, join yarn in the 5th tr of any scallop.

Next round: Ch1, 1dc in same st, ch9, *1dc in the 5th tr of next scallop, ch9* rep from * all around, close with slst in first dc.

Next round: This round only! Work all stitches in the actual chains, not the chain space. Ch3 (count as tr), 1tr in each ch across, but do not work any sts in the dc's. Close with slst in 3rd ch. **Fasten off.**

Next round: With Paris, join yarn in the first tr of any gtr group. Ch1, 1dc in same st, 1dc

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in the next 4 sts, *ch9, sk next 8 tr, 1dc in the next 10 sts*, rep from * to last 13 sts, ch9, sk next 8 sts, 1dc in last 5 sts, close with slst in first dc.

Next round: This round only! Work all stitches in the actual chains, not the chain space.

Ch1, 1dc in same st, 1dc in the next 2 sts, *ch2, 1tr in each of the next 9chs, ch2, sk next 2 sts, 1dc in the next 6 sts*, rep from * to last 9chsp, ch2, 1tr in each of the next 9chs, ch2, sk next 2 dc's, 1dc in the next 3 dc, close with slst in first dc.

Next round: Ch1, 1dc in same st, 1dc in the next st, *ch3, 1tr in each of the next 9tr, ch3, sk next dc, 1dc in the next 4 sts*, rep from * to last repeat, ch3, 1tr in each of the next 9 tr, ch3, sk next dc, 1dc in the next 2 dc, close with slst in first dc.

Next round: Ch1, 1dc in same st, *ch3, (1tr in the next tr, ch1) 8 times, 1tr in the last tr, ch3, sk next dc, 1dc in the next st*, rep from * all around, ch3, close with slst in first dc. **Fasten off.**

Next round: With Lavender, join yarn in any first dc, ch1, 2dctog over this and next dc, *ch3, (1dc in next tr, 1dc in next sp, 1picot) 8 times, 1dc in next tr, ch3, 2dctog over next 2 dc*, rep from * all around close with slst in first 2dctog.

The last repeat will not end with a 2dctog, but will end with a ch3. Fasten off.

FINISH UP

Weave in all loose ends and block according to measurements.

ABOUT THE YARNS

Eco-Bamboo is a luxurious yarn that shimmers and has a wonderful drape. This yarn has 125 meters to a ball. It is 100% bamboo and is lovingly hand-dyed in South Africa.
