NURTURING FIBRES

SKILL LEVEL

Easy

MEASUREMENTS

Blocked measurements:

MATERIALS

Nurturing Fibres 125m/50g

Eco-Bamboo

4 balls in Mist

1 ball in Old Gold

Hook: 5.50mm

Tapestry Needle

Scissors

GAUGE

This pattern is not gauge sensitive, but work very loosely throughout.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg – beg/inning

ch/s – chain

chsp/s – chain space/s

dtr – double treble

rep – repeat

sk – skip

st/s – stitch/es

tr – treble

IMPORTANT! PATTERN NOTES

- Pattern is written in UK terminology
- Each row of the body of the shawl starts with ch5. This counts as a dtr, ch1.
- Ch3 counts as a treble.



INSTRUCTIONS

With a 5.50mm hook and Mist make a magic circle OR ch 6.

Row 1:

Magic circle:

Ch5, 3dtr, ch3, 3dtr, ch1, 1dtr, turn.

OR:

Ch6: 3dtr, ch3, 3dtr, ch1, 1dtr, all in the 7th ch from the hook, turn.

Row 2: Ch5, 3dtr in the first 1chsp, ch3, (3dtr, ch3, 3dtr) in the 3chsp (*creating the point*), ch3, 3dtr in the last 1chsp, ch1, 1dtr in the 4th ch, turn.

Row 3: Ch5, 3dtr in the first 1chsp, ch3, 3dtr in the next 3chsp, ch3, (3dtr, ch3, 3dtr) in the 3chsp-point, ch3, 3dtr in the next 3chsp, ch3, 3dtr in the last 1chsp, ch1, 1dtr in the 4th ch, turn.

Row 4: Ch5, 3dtr in the first 1chsp, ch3, *3dtr in the next 3chsp, ch3*, rep to point, (3dtr, ch3, 3dtr) in the 3chsp-point, *ch3, 3dtr in the next 3chsp*, rep to end, ch3, 3dtr in the last 1chsp, ch1, 1dtr in the 4th ch, turn.

Row 5 – 31: Rep row 4. Fasten off and turn.

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BORDER

With Old Gold, join yarn at the beginning of the row.

Row 32 – 33: Rep row 4

Row 34: Ch3, 1tr between the 2nd and 3rd dtr, 2tr between the next 2 dtr, 2tr in the next 3chsp, *(2tr between the next 2 dtr) twice, 2tr in the next 3chsp*, rep from * to the point, (2tr between the next 2 dtr) twice, (3tr, ch3, 3tr) in the 3chsp-point, (2tr between the next 2dtr) twice, 2tr in the next 3chsp, *(2tr between the next 2 dtr) twice, 2tr in the next 3chsp*, rep to the last 4dtr, 2tr between the next 2 dtr, 1tr between the next 2 dtr, 1tr in the 4th ch, turn.

Row 35: Ch3, 1tr between the 1st and 2nd tr, 1tr in each tr to the 3chsp-point, (3tr, ch3, 3tr) in the 3chsp, 1tr in each tr to the last 2 tr, 1tr between the last 2 tr, 1tr in the last tr. Fasten off.

FINISH UP

Weave in all loose ends.



ABOUT THE YARNS

Eco-Bamboo is a luxurious yarn that shimmers and has a wonderful drape. This yarn has 125 meters to a ball. It is 100% bamboo and is lovingly hand-dyed in South Africa.
