# Dennis The Dragon

#### PATTERN DIFFICULTY

Advanced beginners

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Pattern Size:

Dennis measures approx. 21cm in length

#### MATERIALS

#### **Nurturing Fibres Eco-Cotton**

125m/50g: 3 balls in main colour 3 balls in contrasting colours Hook: 3.25mm Tapestry Needle

Tapestry Need Scissors

2x 15mm safety eyes Pins

Fibrefill

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

2dctog – work two dc's together (decreasing) dc – Double crochet inc – Increase rev dc – Reverse double crochet sl st – slip stitch – sl- sl st st/es – stitch/es tr – treble yoh – yarn over hook

## IMPORTANT! PATTERN NOTES

- The pattern is written in UK terminology
- The pattern is worked in a spiral. Be sure to mark the first st of every round with a stitch marker
- The dragon is made with 15 separate parts and sewn together later. When assembling, use pins to secure the separate parts before sewing together as they could be quite fiddly.

#### SPECIAL STITCHES

The reverse double crochet stitch: (Same as for a regular double crochet, only in reverse. instead of inserting needle in left st, insert needle into right st, working backwards: (yoh, bring through the st on your right, yoh, bring through two loops on the hook.)

#### INSTRUCTIONS



#### HEAD

With main colour make a magic circle OR ch 2 and work all the stitches of the first round in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain stitch: (Remember to read the pattern notes before proceeding!)

Round 1: 8dc, pull closed. (8dc)
Round 2: 2dc in each st. (16dc)
Round 2: (1dc in part et ade in

Round 3: (1dc in next st, 2dc in

next st)  $\times$  8 (24dc)

Round 4: (1dc in next 2 sts, 2dc in next st) x 8 (32dc)

Dought St/ X O (320C)

Round 5: (1dc in next 3 sts, 2dc

in next st) x 8 (**40dc**)

Round 6: (1dc in next 4 sts, 2dc in next st) x 8 (48dc)

Round 7: (1dc in next 5 sts, 2dc in next st) x 8 (56dc)

**Round 8-13:** 1dc in each st. (56dc)

Round 14: (1dc in next 5 sts. 2dctog over next 2 sts) x 8 (48dc)

Round 15: 1dc in each st. (48dc) Round 16: (1dc in next 4 sts, 2dctog over next two sts) x 8 (40dc)

Round 17-28: 1dc in each st. (40dc)

Round 29: 2sts in the next 20 sts, 1st in the next 20 sts.

(60dc)

**Round 30-31:** 1dc in each st. (**60dc**)

Round 32: (1dc in the next 8 sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (54dc)

Round 33: 1dc in each st. (54dc) Round 34: (1dc in the next 7 sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (48dc)

Round 35: 1dc in each st. (48dc) Round 36: (1dc in the next 6 sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (42dc)

Place the eyes: Count 13 sts from marker, add safety eyes between round 31-32, leaving 11 sts between eyes.

Round 37: (1dc in the 5 sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (36dc)

Round 38: 1dc in each st. (36dc)

Round 39: (1dc in the next 4 sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (30dc)

Round 40: 1dc in each st. (30dc)

Round 41: (1dc in the next 3 sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (24dc)

Round 42: 1dc in each st. (24dc)

Round 43: (1dc in the next 2 sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (18dc)

Round 44: 1dc in each st. (18dc) Round 45: (1dc in next st. 2dctog over the next two sts x

8 (**9dc**)

Fasten off, stuff firmly and sew closed.

Sew a crisscross stitch over rounds 9-10, for nostrils.

#### BODY

With main colour, make a magic circle OR ch 2 and work all the stitches of the first round in the 1<sup>st</sup> chain stitch

Round 1: 8dc, pull closed. (8dc) Round 2: Work 2dc in each st. (16dc)

Round 3: (1dc in next st, 2dc in next st) x 8 (24dc)

Round 4: (1dc in the next two sts, 2dc in the next st) x 8 (32dc)

Round 5: (1dc in the next 3 sts, 2dc in the next st) x 8 (40dc)
Round 6: (1dc in the next 4 sts, 2dc in the next st) x 8 (48dc)
Round 7: (1dc in the next 5 sts, 2dc in the next st) x 8 (56dc)
Round 8: (1dc in the next 6 sts, two dc in the next st) x 8 (64dc)
Round 9: (1dc in the next 7 sts, 2dc in the next st) x 8 (72dc)
Round 10: (1dc in the next 8 sts, 2dc in the next st) x 8 (80dc)
Round 11: (1dc in the next 9 sts, 2dc in the next st) x 8 (88dc)
Round 12-18: 1dc in each st.

Round 19: (1dc in the next 9 sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (80dc)

**Round 20-21:** 1dc in each st. (**80dc**)

Round 22: (1dc in the next 8 sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (72dc)

**Round 23-24:** 1dc in each st. (72dc)

Round 25: (1dc in the next 7 sts. 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (64dc)

Round 26: 1dc in each st. (64dc)

Round 27: (1dc in the next 6 sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (56dc)

Round 28: 1dc in each st. (56dc)

Round 29: (1dc in the next 5 sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (48dc)

Round 30: 1dc in each st. (48dc)

Round 31: (1dc in the next 4 sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (40dc)

Round 32: 1dc in each st. (40dc) Round 31: (1dc in the next 3 sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (32dc)

Round 32: 1dc in each st. (32dc) Round 31: (1dc in the next two sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (24dc)

Round 31: (1dc in the next st, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (16dc)

Fasten off and leave a 15cm tail

#### EARS (MAKE TWO)

With main colour, make a magic circle OR ch 2 and work all the stitches of the first round in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain stitch.

Round 1: 6 dc, pull closed. (6dc)

Round 2: (2dc in the next st, 1dc in the next st) x 6 (9dc)
Round 3: (2dc in the next st, 1dc in the next st) x 4. Work 2dc in the last st. (14dc)
Round 4-8: 1 dc in each st.

Fasten off and leave a 15cm tail to sew.

#### TAIL

With main colour, make a magic circle OR ch 2 and work all the stitches of the first round in the 2nd chain stitch.

Round 1: 6dc, pull closed. (6dc) Rnd 2-32: Work 2dc in every first st of every round, until you end up with 37 sts, firmly stuff with fiberfill.



(88dc)

#### ARMS (MAKE TWO)

With any contrasting colour, make a magic circle OR ch 2 and work all the stitches of the first round in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain stitch.

Round 1: 8dc, pull closed. (8dc) Round 2: Work 2dc in each st. (16dc)

Round 3: (2dc in the next st, 1 dc in the next st) x 8 (24dc)
Round 4: (2dc in the next st, 1 dc in the next 2 sts) x 6 (32dc)

And change to main colour on final st: insert hook into last st, yoh and bring through st, yoh with new colour yarn, pull through two loops on hook. Leave a 15cm tail of the contrasting colour and thread through round 6-7 when these rounds are completed. (This will be used later for paw claws.) Continue with main colour.

Round 5: (2dc in the next st, 1dc in the next 3 sts) x 8 (40dc)
Round 6-7: 1dc in each st.
(40dc)

Round 8: (1dc in the next 3 sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (32dc)

Round 9: (1dc in the next 2 sts, 2dctog over the next sts) x 8 (24dc)

Round 10: (1dc in the next st, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (16dc)

**Round 11-26**: 1dc in each st. (16dc)

Stuff paw front firmly with fiberfill, stuff arms loosely,

sewing three stitches, over Round 6 & 7 for claws, fasten off and leave tail for sewing.

#### LEGS (MAKE TWO)

With the same contrasting colour as the arms, make a magic circle OR ch 2 and work all the stitches of the first round in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain stitch.

Round 1: 8dc, pull closed. (8dc)
Round 2: 2dc in each st. (16dc)
Round 3: (2dc in next st, 1dc in next st) x 8. (24dc)
Round 4: (2dc in next st, 1dc in next 2 sts) x 8 (32dc)
Round 5: (2dc in next st, 1dc in next 3 sts) x 8 (40dc)

Change to main colour as per the arms, leaving a 15cm tail. Weave this yarn tail through rounds 7 – 8 once they've been completed. Continue with main colour

Round 6: (2dc in the next st, 1dc in the next 4 sts) x 8 (48dc)
Round 7-8: 1dc in each st.
(48dc)

Round 9: (1dc in the next 4 sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (40dc)

Round 10: (1dc in the next 3 sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (32dc)

Round 11: (1dc in the next 2 sts, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (24dc)

Round 12: (1dc in the next st, 2dctog over the next two sts) x 8 (16dc)

**Round 13-34:** 1dc in each st. (16dc)

Stuff firmly with fiberfill, sewing three stitches, over Round 7 & 8 for claws, fasten off and leave tail for sewing.

#### DRAGON SPIKES (Make 5:

Two in the same contrasting colour, 1 in a main colour, 1 each in the two remaining contrasting colours)

Make a magic circle OR ch 2 and work all the stitches of the first round in the 1<sup>st</sup> chain stitch.

Round 1: 6dc, pull closed. (6dc)
Round 2: (2dc in the next st,
1dc in the next st). x 3 (9dc)
Round 3: (2dc in the next st,
1dc in the next st) x 4, 2dc in
the last st. (14dc)
Round 4-5: 1dc in each st.
(14dc)

Round 6: (2dc in the next st, 1dc in the next two sts) x 4, 2dc in the last st. (19dc)

Rnd 7-8: 1dc in each st. (19dc) Fasten off and leave 15cm tail to sew. Do not stuff.

#### WINGS (MAKE TWO)

With main colour, make a magic circle OR ch 2 and work all the stitches of the first round in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain stitch.

Round 1: 12tr, pull closed. (12tr)
Round 2: 2tr in the next st, 1tr in
the next st. (24tr)
Round 3: (1tr in the next st, 2tr
in the next st) x 8 (36tr)

Round 4: 1tr in each st. (36tr)
Fasten off and join with the
same contrasting colour as the
arms and legs as follows: fold

circle in half, and dc through both front and backstitches creating a semi-circle (**16dc**) Revdc back 16 sts, to create a lovely border. **(16dc)** Fasten off.

#### FINISH UP

Pin all the pieces in place and sew together.

**Eco-Cotton** is a softly spun yarn with 125 meters to a ball. It is 100% cotton and lovingly hand-dyed in South Africa.
