#### PATTERN DIFFICULTY

Moderate

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Width: 80cm Length: 160cm

#### MATERIALS

Nurturing Fibres Eco-Lush
3 balls of 200m/50g in Lilac
1 ball of 200mm/50g in
Vanilla
Needle size: 3mm
Tapestry Needle
Scissors

# IMPORTANT! PATTERN NOTES

While this pattern is a fixed pattern, you can easily increase or decrease the size.

If your stitch count is off by 1 or 2, it will not affect the overall look of the garment.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

Sts - stitches k- Knit p- Purl Yo- Yarn over K2tog - Knit 2 together Kfb- Knit front and back Pfb- Purl front and back Sl - slip

#### INSTRUCTIONS



#### THE BODY

Using Colour 1 [Main colour] and 3mm knitting needles, cast on 3 sts

Row 1: P

Row 2: yo, K to end Repeat row 1 and 2 until you have 26 sts and end on a k row

Change to colour 2.

Row 47: P

Row 48: Yo, K1, (yo, K2tog until 2 sts remain) Yo, k, k
Repeat row 47 and 48 until
you have completed 2
repeats [with a total of 4
rows] in the second colour.
[30 sts]

Change to colour 1

Row 51: P

Row 52: yo, K to end Repeat row 1 and 2 until you have 51 sts and end on a k row

Change to colour 2.

Row 93: P

Row 94: Yo, K1, (yo, K2tog until 2 sts remain) Yo, k, k

Repeat row 93 and 94 until you have completed 3 repeats [with a total of 6 rows] in the second colour. [57sts]

Change to colour 1

Row 99: P

Row 100: yo, K to end Repeat row 1 and 2 until you have 77 sts and end on a k row

Change to colour 2.

Row 139: P

Row 140: Yo, K1, (yo, K2tog until 2 sts remain) Yo, k, k
Repeat row 139 and 140 until you have completed 4
repeats [with a total of 8 rows] in the second colour.
[85sts]

Change to colour 1

Row 147: P

Row 148: yo, K to end Repeat row 1 and 2 until you have 104 sts and end on a k row

Change to colour 2.

Row 185: P

Row 186: Yo, K1, (yo, K2tog until 2 sts remain) Yo, k, k
Repeat row 185 and 186 until
you have completed 5
repeats [with a total of 10
rows] in the second colour.
[114 sts]

Change to colour 1

Row 195: P

Row 196: yo, K to end

Repeat row 1 and 2 until you have 132 sts and end on a k row

Change to colour 2.

Row 231: P

Row 232: Yo, K1, (yo, K2tog until 2 sts remain) Yo, k, k
Repeat row 231 and 232 until
you have completed 6
repeats [with a total of 12
rows] in the second colour.
[144 sts]

Change to colour 1

Row 243: P

Row 244: yo, K to end Repeat row 1 and 2 until you have 161 sts and end on a k row

Change to colour 2.

Row 277: P

Row 278: Yo, K1, (yo, K2tog until 2 sts remain) Yo, k, k
Repeat row 277 and 278 until
you have completed 7
repeats [with a total of 14
rows] in the second colour.
[175 sts]

Change to colour 1
Row 291: P
Row 292: yo, K to end
Repeat row 1 and 2 until you
have 191 sts and end on a k
row

Leave the main colour attached

Change to colour 2.

Row 323: P

Row 324: Yo, K1, (yo, K2tog until 2 sts remain) Yo, k, k

Repeat row 323 and 324 until you have completed 6 repeats [with a total of 12 rows] in the second colour. [203 sts]

Row 335: P

#### BORDER

(yo, K2tog until 2 sts remain)
Yo, k1, kfb, place marker, k1
[206 sts]
Pick up 170 sts along the
edge and knit as follows:
With colour 2: Place marker,
Kfb, yo, (k2 tog, yo, k2tog, yo,
k1, yo), change to main
colour while taking care to
cross the yarn. ((kf, yo, kb in
the next stitch), yo, k, yo, k,
yo) Repeat until 1 st remain,
k1

Row 1: (With colour 2) Yo. K1.

Row 2: P 433st in main colour, change colour while taking care to cross the yarn when changing colours. P 14st in colour 2, slip marker, k1, slip marker, k to end in colour 2

Continue with the colours as explained above. (see figure A) Remember when changing colour, to cross the yarn so that the 2 colours are secure together.

Row 3: Yo, K1, (yo, K2tog until 2 sts remain) Yo, k1, kfb, slip marker, k1, slip marker, kfb, k1. (yo, k2tog) until 1 st remains, Yo, k1

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: Yo, k1, (yo, k2tog, yo, yo, k2tog) to 2sts before the stitch marker, k2, slip marker, k1, slip marker, k1, yo, (k2tog, yo,) until 1 st remains, yo, k1

Row 6: Purl

#### CAST OFF

Cast off 3 sts, ((SI the st to the left needle and k)x3. Insert left needle into the base of the 1st st and knit. Insert the left needle into the front of the 2 sts and k them together, Cast off 2 sts) continue with this until you reach the marker, remove the marker. ((SI the st to the left needle and k)x3. Insert left needle into the base of the 1st st and knit. Insert the left needle into the front of the 2 sts and k them together, Remove the marker Cast of 3 sts)

((SI the st to the left needle and k)x3. Insert left needle into the base of the 1st st and knit. Insert the left needle into the front of the 2 sts and k them together, Cast off 2 sts) Continue to end

#### FINISH UP

Weave in all remaining loose ends and block to preferred size.

#### ABOUT THE YARN

Eco-Lush is an uber soft and squishy yarn that has a wonderful drape. This yarn has 200 meters to a ball. It is 60% cotton and 40% bamboo and lovingly handdyed in South Africa.
