NURTURING FIBRES

PATTERN DIFFICULTY

Easy - Intermediate

MEASUREMENTS

Pattern Sizes:

Small, medium, large

Completed measurements:

To fit size 32, 34, 36 (82cm, 87cm, 92cm)

Length from shoulder to hem:

53cm (all sizes)

MATERIALS

5 (5, 6) balls 125m/50g

Nurturing Fibres Eco-Fusion

Colour Cobblestone

5 (5, 6) balls 125m/50g

Nurturing Fibres Eco-Bamboo

Colour Mist

Needles: 5.00mm

Tapestry Needle

Scissors

GAUGE

18 sts x 28 rows = 10x10cm
using 5.00mm needles and
working in pattern as set.

ABBREVIATIONS

cont - continue

k - knit

k2tog - knit two stitches

together

p - purl

patt - pattern

rep - repeat

RS - right side

ssk - slip, slip, knit

st/s - stitch/es

WS - wrong side

IMPORTANT! PATTERN NOTES

The pattern is worked throughout with two strands of yarn, one in Eco-Bamboo, one in Eco-Fusion.

For a great fit, ensure that your gauge is the same as given above. If you don't get to the same gauge, simply use bigger or smaller needles.

Note that the back is longer than the front.



INSTRUCTIONS

BACK

With 1 strand of Eco-Bamboo in colour Mist and 1 strand of Eco-Fusion in colour Cobblestone and using 5.00mm needles cast-on 67 (79) sts, using your preferred method.

Row 1: (WS) K3, *p1, k3*, rep from * to end turn.

Row 2: K.

Row 3 - 39: Rep row 1 and 2.

Row 40: K8, k2tog, k to last 10 sts, k2tog, k to end, turn.

Row 41: (k3, p1) twice, k2, p1, (k3, p1) to last 10 sts, k2, p1, k3, p1, k3, turn.

Row 42: K8, k2tog, k to last 10 sts, k2tog, k to end, turn.

Row 43: (k3, p1) twice, k1, p1, (k3, p1) to last 9 sts, k1, p1, k3, p1, k3, turn.

Row 44: K7, ssk, k to last 9 sts, k2tog, k to end, turn.

Row 45: (k3, p1) twice, p1, (k3, p1) to last 8 sts, p1, k3, p1, k3, turn.

Row 46: K7, ssk, k to last 9 sts, k2tog, k to end, turn.

Row 47 - 67: Rep patt as set.

Row 68 - 74: Rep row 40 - 46.

Row 75 - 139: Rep patt as set.

Loosely cast off all stitches.

FRONT



With 1 strand of Eco-Bamboo in colour Mist and 1 strand of Eco-Fusion in colour Cobblestone and using 5.00mm needles cast-on 67 (79) sts, using your preferred method.

Row 1: (WS) K3, *p1, k3*, rep from * to end turn.

Row 2: K.

Row 3 - 29: Rep row 1 and 2.

Row 30: K8, k2tog, k to last 10 sts, k2tog, k to end, turn.

NURTURING FIBRES

Row 31: (k3, p1) twice, k2, p1, (k3, p1) to last 10 sts, k2, p1, k3, p1, k3, turn.

Row 32: K8, k2tog, k to last 10 sts, k2tog, k to end, turn.

Row 33: (k3, p1) twice, k1, p1, (k3, p1) to last 9 sts, k1, p1, k3, p1, k3, turn.

Row 34: K7, ssk, k to last 9 sts, k2tog, k to end, turn.

Row 35: (k3, p1) twice, p1, (k3, p1) to last 8 sts, p1, k3, p1, k3, turn.

Row 36: K7, ssk, k to last 9 sts, k2tog, k to end, turn.

Row 37 – 57: Rep patt as set.

Row 58 – 64: Rep row 30 – 36.

Row 65 – 129: Rep patt as set.

Loosely cast off all stitches.



FINISH UP

With wrong sides facing sew 5cm shoulder seams.

Sew the sides together, leaving a 26cm sleeve opening and an 11cm side slit.

Weave in all remaining loose ends. It is not necessary to block this project.

ABOUT THE YARNS

Eco-Fusion is a uniquely spun yarn with 125 meters to a ball. It is 50% bamboo and 50% cotton & lovingly hand dyed in South Africa.

Eco-Bamboo is a luxurious yarn that shimmers and has a wonderful drape. This yarn has 125 meters to a ball. It is 100% bamboo and is lovingly hand-dyed in South Africa.
