NURTURING FIBRES

PATTERN DIFFICULTY

Beginner/Intermediate

MEASUREMENTS

Pattern Sizes:

One Size Fits All

Completed measurements:

Length- 1.6 m

Width- 13 cm

MATERIALS

Nurturing Fibres SuperTwist

Sock (320m/100g)

1x Candy

1x Vanilla

1x Odette

Hook: 3.5 mm

Tapestry Needle

Scissors

ABBREVIATIONS

bpdc - back post double
crochet

ch - chain

ch-sp - chain space

dc - double crochet

fpdc - front post double
crochet

hdc - half double crochet

sc - single crochet

st(s)- stitch(es)

IMPORTANT! PATTERN NOTES

- The main body of the scarf is worked using the moss stitch; the ch 2 at the beginning of each row counts as one moss stitch (sc and ch 1).
- Pattern is written in US terminology.

INSTRUCTIONS

MAIN BODY OF SCARF

Using Candy, ch 40

Row 1: sc in the 4th ch from the hook, [ch 1 , skip 1 ch, sc in the next ch] – repeat [...] to the end. The last stitch should be a sc, turn.

Row 2: ch 2, sc in the first ch-1 space, [ch 1, sc in the next ch-1 space]- repeat [...] to the end of the row. The last sc will be made in the ch-3 space made at the start of row 1, turn.

Row 3: ch 2, sc in the first ch-1 space, [ch 1, sc in the next ch-1 space], repeat [...] to the end of the row. The last sc will be made in the ch-2 space from row 2, turn.

Rows 4-280: Repeat Row 3, cut yarn and fasten off, change to Odette.

SCARF ENDS – TO BE REPEATED ON BOTH SIDES OF THE BODY OF THE SCARF

Rows 281-282: With Odette repeat row 3 above for 2 rows, cut yarn and fasten off. Change to Vanilla.

Rows 283-284: With Vanilla repeat row 3 above for 2 rows, cut yarn and fasten off. Change back to Odette.

Rows 285-286: With Odette repeat row 3 above for 2 rows, cut yarn and fasten off.

Change to Candy.

Rows 287-294: With Candy repeat row 3 above for 8 rows.

Rows 295-306: ch 3, hdc in the first ch-1 space, [ch 1, hdc in the next ch-1 space], repeat [...] to the end of the row. The last hdc will be made in the ch-2 space from row 294. Repeat row 295 for 12 rows.

Row 307: ch 2, hdc in every st to the end of the row, cut yarn, fasten off. Change back to Odette.

Row 308: With Odette ch 3, fpdc around every st to the end of the row.

Row 309: ch 3, bpdc around every st to the end of the row, cut yarn and fasten off.

Change back to Candy.

Row 310: ch 2, hdc in every st to the end of the row.

Row: 311: ch 3, 3dc in next st, [ch 1, skip 1, 3dc in next st], repeat this until the 2nd last st, dc in the last st, cut yarn and fasten off.

Repeat Rows 281-311 (the scarf end section) on the opposite end of the scarf.

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FINISH UP

Weave in all loose ends. Block scarf for a straight, neat finish.

CINCHED ENDS

With Vanilla, ch 70 x2 (one for each end of the scarf) , cut yarn and fasten off. With the right side of the scarf facing you, thread the ch 70 into the 1st ch-1 space of Row 283, skip the next ch-1 space, bring the ch 70 out of the next ch-1 space, repeat this until the end of row. Turn your scarf over to the wrong side, pull the ch tight and tie with a bow to the back of your scarf.



ABOUT THE YARNS

SuperTwist Sock is a versatile yarn that is 100% merino wool from non-mulesed sheep. It has 320m to a skein and lovingly hand-dyed in South Africa.
