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## PATTERN DIFFICULTY

Advanced Beginners

## MEASUREMENTS

Wingspan:

Approx 116cm

Depth: Approx 45cm

## MATERIALS

4 x balls Nurturing Fibres Eco-Bamboo 125m/50g in the colour/s of your choice.

Hook: 4.00mm

Tapestry Needle

Scissors

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch/s – chain/s

prev - previous

rep – repeat

RS – right side

sk – skip

slst – slip stitch

sp - space

st/s – stitch/es

tr – treble

## IMPORTANT! PATTERN NOTES

- Pattern is written in UK terminology
- Corner-2-corner crochet is created by blocks. With each row, a block is added and each block consists of three chains at its beginning (that counts as a treble stitch) and 3 treble stitches. Each block is created next to a previous block and the stitches for the new block is worked around the beginning 3 chains of the block from the previous row.

## INSTRUCTIONS



**Row 1:** Ch6 and work 1tr in 4th ch from the hook and in the next 2 ch, turn. (1 block)

**Row 2:** Ch6, 1tr in the 4th ch from hook and in the next 2 ch, (slst, ch3, 3tr) all in the 3chsp of the previous row, turn. (2 blocks)

**Row 3:** Ch6, 1tr in the 4th ch from hook and in next 2 ch, [(slst, ch3, 3tr) all in next 3chsp of previous row] twice, turn. (3 blocks)

**Row 4:** Ch6, 1tr in the 4th ch from hook and in the next 2 ch, [(slst, ch3, 3tr) all in next 3chsp of previous row] to end of row, turn. (4 blocks)

**Row 5-45:** Rep row 4.

**For a bigger shawl, simply work additional rows, but be sure to end with an uneven numbered row.**

## BORDER

*Do not fasten off, and do not turn, but continue for the border: (You'll now be working on the straight edge of the shawl)*

Ch3, work 3 tr at the base of the ch3, slst into the 3chsp below the last block made during the last row of the shawl, ch3, work 3tr in the same sp, \*sk the next 3tr, slst in the sp between the current and next block, ch3, work 3tr in the same sp, sk the tr and slst in the sp between the current and next block, ch3, work 3tr in the same sp\*, rep from \* all around both the straight edges. (Each block/row will have a little scalloped edge). Fasten off.

## FINISH UP

Weave in all remaining loose ends, and block if preferred.

## ABOUT THE YARN

Eco-Bamboo is a luxurious yarn that shimmers and has a wonderful drape. This yarn has 125 meters to a ball. It is 100% bamboo and lovingly hand-dyed in South Africa.

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
