Pattern Sizes:

One Size Only

Completed measurements:

32x43cm

MATERIALS

Nurturing Fibres Eco-Cotton

(50g/125m)

2x Vanilla

1x Watershed

1x Mint

Hook: 4.00mm

Tapestry Needle

Scissors

ABBREVIATIONS

ch – chain

chsp – chain space

cont - continue

dc – double crochet

slst – slip stitch

sk – skip

tr - treble

GAUGE

This project is not gauge sensitive.

IMPORTANT!

PATTERN NOTES

- Pattern is written in UK terminology
- Work ch3 at the beginning of tr rounds. This counts as a stitch.
- Work 1ch at beginning of dc rounds. This doesn't count as a stitch.
- The post of the stitch refers to the actual body of the stitch.



INSTRUCTIONS

With Vanilla and a 4.00mm hook, ch6.

Row 1: Work 1tr in 4th ch from the hook and in the next 2 ch, turn. (1 block)

Row 2: Ch6, 1tr in the 4th ch from hook and in the next 2 ch, (slst, ch3, 3tr) all in the 3chsp of the previous row, turn. (2 blocks)

Row 3: Ch6, 1tr in the 4th ch from hook and in next 2 ch, [(slst, ch3, 3tr) all in next 3chsp of previous row] twice, turn. (3 blocks)

Row 4: Ch6, 1tr in the 4th ch from hook and in the next 2 ch, [(slst, ch3, 3tr) all in next 3chsp of previous row] 3 times, turn. (4 blocks)

Next rows: Cont increasing in this manner, until there are 8 blocks across, then change colour. Work 1 row in Mint, change back to Vanilla and work 1 row, change to Watershed and work 3 rows, change back to Vanilla and work 1 row, change to Mint

and work 1 row, change back to Vanilla and work an additional 5 rows. (20 blocks across)

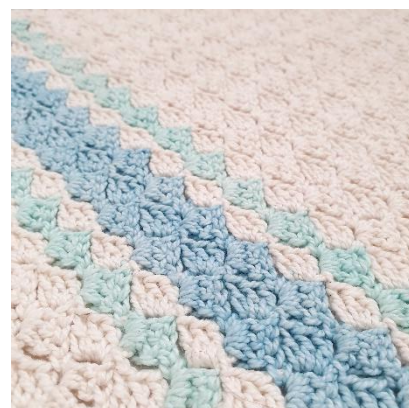
Next row: Ch6, 1tr in the 4th ch from hook and in the next 2 ch, *(slst, ch3, 3tr) all in next 3chsp of previous row*, rep from * to last block of previous row, 1slst in the 3rd ch of this last block of the previous row, turn. (*Only 1 increase made on the right hand side of the work* - 20 x 21 blocks)

Next row: Slst across the first 3 tr, *(slst, ch3, 3tr) all in next 3chsp of previous row*, rep from * to the end of the row, turn. (*Only 1 increase made on the left hand side of the work* - 20 x 22 blocks.)

Rep prev 2 rows until there are 20 x 26 blocks across.

Next row: Slst across the first 3 tr, *(slst, ch3, 3tr) all in next the 3chsp of previous row*, rep from * to last 3chsp, slst in last sp, turn, **do NOT** make a block in last space.

Rep previous row until the rectangle is complete. Fasten off.



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EDGING

Join Vanilla in any st. Work a round of evenly spaced dc all round. Work 3 dc in each corner. Work another round of Vanilla in the same manner and finish off with a round of Watershed. Remember to work 3dc in the middle dc of each corner. Fasten off.

FINISH UP

Weave in all remaining ends.



ABOUT THE YARNS

Eco-Cotton is a softly spun yarn with 125 meters to a ball. It is 100% cotton and lovingly hand-dyed in South Africa.
